


Hello again,

Here we are back again after our usual summer break. I hope that you have enjoyed your summer holidays, if you had any, and that you have had also some time for DX'ing. If so, please do not forget to send your news and loggings to our editors.

**Unfortunately we have still not found a new permanent LOGBOOK EDITOR. In this issue you will find OM Eberhard Ahl's final Logbook. Therefore we still need a volunteer for our Logbook section. If you are interested to compile our LOGBOOK in the future, please do not hesitate to contact us. We shall be pleased to inform you about all necessary details.**

And now over to our usual news from other clubs and organizations: Egypt will host the brand new ITU Telecom Event **MIDDLE EAST AND ARAB STATES 2001**, which will be held from May 7th to 10th, 2001 at the Cairo International Conference Centre. The venue is ideally located and offers advanced exhibition and forum facilities. It was previously used by the ITU to stage the highly successful Africa TELECOM 94 event. The MIDDLE EAST AND ARAB STATES 2001 exhibition will feature an impressive range of telecommunications-related products and services, while the associated forum will focus on the latest telecommunication developments and growth and will provide a platform for telecommunication leaders to share their ideas on future trends and discuss appropriate strategies for the developing as well as the industrialized world.

The event will be the 24th TELECOM event since World TELECOM was first held in Geneva in 1971. The regional events, which include TELECOMs for the Americas, Asia-Pacific and Africa regions, were introduced in 1985 in order to address the more specific concerns of the individual regions. Since then these events have grown in size and prestige and have become the most respected and authoritative in the world. The world events are now held in four year cycles and the regionals in two year cycles in order to ensure adequate global coverage across all 189 Member States of the ITU.

The next ITU TELECOM event being held is ASIA 2000, which is being hosted by the Government of the People's Republic of China in Hong Kong, from 4 to 9 December 2000. After MIDDLE EAST AND ARAB STATES 2001 has ended on 10 May 2001, the ITU will organize the fifth regional TELECOM event for the Africa region. AFRICA 2001 will be hosted by the Government of the Republic of South Africa and will be staged from 12 to 16 November. It will be followed by AMERICAS and ASIA events in 2002. Completing the current four year cycle will be ITU TELECOM WORLD 2003, which will take place at Palexpo in Geneva from 12 to 18 October 2003.

**Australasian Shortwave Guide**, edition number 10, 24 pages A4. Comprehensive information of shortwave transmissions in all languages beamed to Australia/Pacific, and for broadcasts in English to Asia, the Pacific, the Far East, Siberia, and the Indian sub-continent. Data arranged two sections - by order of studio country and program start time. Gives broadcast organisations, frequencies, start times, end times, languages, target areas, transmitter sites/countries, studio countries, broadcast days.

**Asia Pacific Shortwave Guide**, Edition Number 2, 28 pages A4. Features external service schedules in all languages of most countries in Asia, the Far East, the Pacific, and the Indian sub-continent. Nearly 5000 entries. Arranged in two sections - by Studio Country and by Frequency. Gives organisations, frequencies, start times, end times, languages, targets, transmitter sites/countries, relay sites, and days.

Each publication is offered: in print (hard copy) format, or electronically delivered via E-mail, or postal mailed on 3" diskette. Prices for each guide: A\$10 - within Australia; A\$15/US\$10/10 IRCs - airmail outside of Australia. The price is the same for the three methods of delivery. The 2000 edition of the **European NDB Handbook** by Michael Oexner has been published recently. This new 2000 edition has been continuously worked upon to give you the most up to date NDB information available. Its over 120 spiral-bound pages in DIN A4 format now contain data of more than 3500 active NDBs located in Europe, the Northern African countries, and the Near and Middle East. Many of the more frequently heard transatlantic NDBs have been included, as well as NDBs operating from offshore installations such as oil platforms. Moreover the handbook includes widely reported unidentified beacons and irregular call signs which originate from so-called "negative keying". One or the other NDB mystery may be solved with this information on hand. As a new feature, the 2000 edition now shows the NDB modulation frequency as monitored by a network of active NDB DXers. Part 1 (the reference list) shows the entries sorted by alphabetical order of the call sign and lists the carrier frequency, the modulation frequency, the authority or company taking care of the NDB, name and location of the NDB, country in ITU code, geographical coordinates, distance and Great Circle bearing. Part 2 of the handbook is sorted in frequency order, and part 3 in country order. As a special benefit to the users of this handbook, the distance and Great Circle bearing have been computed for the individual listener's location. Please don't forget to specify the geographic coordinates of your listening post when ordering (recommended format to be used: degrees/minutes/seconds). Please mention whether you prefer the distance shown either in kilometers or in miles. To give newcomers an easy start, the handbook includes a table showing those NDBs that are nearest to your location. And for those that are unfamiliar with Morse code, a reference table is included. **AUSTRALIA:** The Darwin transmitter site in Australia's Northern Territory is to be leased to *Christian Vision*, the UK-based religious broadcasting organisation which operates Christian Voice in Zambia and Chile. Registered frequency of Christian Voice for B-00 via Darwin tx:

17775 0900-2000 DRW 100 kW / 303 degrs in E to zone 41 (SoAS).

Information about test transmissions of Christian Voice, the U.K. based evangelical broadcaster which has taken over the former Radio Australia shortwave facility near Darwin. The tests will run from 2230 to 230 UTC on, at various times, 6010, 13585, 17775, and 21680 kHz, until October 28th. (Gene Anderson via Communications World Script 23 September 2000, via JKB)

**AUSTRIA:** The budget for the next year of *Radio Austria International* will be 90 millions ATS (about 23 million US-Dollar, ed.), slightly more than a half of the previous one. ROI will cut by about a half Arabic, Esperanto and Spanish. The whole program volume is to be reduced from around the clock to 14 hours. ROI will maintain all own satellite outlets in 2001, including the one in the "Astra Digital Radio" system, which meanwhile started to become obsolete. To manage this it was unavoidable to cancel the anyway rather erratic relays by the German Radioropa 261 longwave service as well as the contract with World Radio Network. WRN will probably continue ROI broadcasts. On shortwave ROI will continue to serve all target areas for "at least one hour per day", the airtime exchange with RCI will continue but cut to a single hour per day only. During the recent weeks ROI moved from the ORF center into the Argentinierstraße radiohouse of the domestic services, for a particularly sensitive hearing resulting in different audio characteristics as it is always the case between different studios. Within the next two weeks the whole equipment from the old ROI headquarter will be installed at the radiohouse, hopefully resulting in a final solution of the problems which occurred recently in the play-out process. **CHINA (Peoples Rep.):** China has revamped its Web site aimed at users around the world. The URL is <http://www.china.org.cn>. It provides content in ten languages. And the Chinese People's Daily recently carried an article about improvements to the **China Radio International Web site** -- <http://www.cri.com.cn>. The article states that, in contrast to shortwave, audio programs transmitted via the Internet are "distinct and stable." The Chinese Peoples Daily article does not mention that China considers international broadcasting via the Internet to be a one-way communications activity. The Web sites of VOA, BBC, and Radio Free Asia are blocked in China. (Communications World Script 19 August 2000, via JKB)

**CROATIA: Croatian Radio** is forced to stop transmission of 'Radio Croatia' via relay Juelich, Germany, as of October 1, 2000. No shutdown of the shortwave transmitters at Deanovec. The last day of broadcasting was Saturday, September 30, 2000. The stuff has done everything in their power to secure the funding and thus continuation of Croatian short wave program. Regrettably, it is the Croatian Government's opinion that short wave is costly and unnecessary, and must be terminated. Due to the nature of short wave, Croatian Information Center cannot secure funding through marketing activities. Unfortunately, without Government backing the project is entirely unsustainable. **CYPRUS:** *Merlin Communications* Internat. has secured a £600.000 contract with BBC WS to project manage the re-engineering of their Ladies Mile txion facility in Limassol, Cyprus. The project will see Merlin manage the replacement of two 500 kW MW txs, 639 and 720 kHz. and the stn's power infrastructure over the two year contract period. The Merlin/BBC SW site is located west of Zyggi coast, south of the highway towards Lanarka. (Merlin press release Jul 6 via BDXC-UK, in ARC - MV-Eko, Sep 25) The Ladies Mile site, on the east coast south of Limassol, was opened in 1978 using four F&CO 250 kW transmitters combined to two 500 kW pairs. At that time the older 2x100 kW Marconi transmitters from 1955 and 1963 were moved to 1323. (Olle Alm-SWE, in ARC - MV-Eko, Sep 25) (Both items via BC-DX #485, 28 Sep 2000)

**CZECH REPUBLIC:** From Oct 29 *Radio Prague* will again use a transmitter in Slovakia. A few years ago they had to discontinue transmissions from Rimavska Sobota due to financial shortage; since than only two 100 kW tx's at Litomysl were used anymore. Also from Oct 29 Radio Prague will start broadcasting in Russian as already reported a while ago. (Andreas Volk via KLE, 27 Sep 2000)

**ISRAEL:** Broadcasts from the *Voice of Israel Arabic channel*, or Network D, on 738 kilohertz medium wave, 1,200 kilowatts, were discontinued this week. This is because the transmitter, near Tel Aviv, lost its radiation permit from Israel Ministerial Committee on Environmental Affairs. Fears of health problems from transmitters have been an issue before in Israel. Such concerns were voiced during planning for the VOA/Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty relay station in that country, which was never built. The Voice of Israel reported that the loss of the transmitter, heard in many parts of the Arab world, brought many protests. The future of the transmitter will be decided at higher levels of the Israeli government. The transmitter was installed in the 1950s, and since then houses and schools have been built in its vicinity. By way of irony, the Tel Aviv newspaper Ha'aretz reported Friday that the environment minister, Dalya Itzik, will become the new head of the *Israel Broadcasting Authority*. (Communications World Script 19 August 2000, via JKB)

**MISCELLANEOUS:** *Media Network* from Radio Netherlands is going to switch to becoming a WEB-ONLY production as from the end of October. The last edition of the radio show will air on Thursday 26th October. So the radio programme would require greater and greater investment in time and effort in order to maintain its leading position. It's time that radio producer and host Jonathan Marks simply doesn't have. Since Diana's departure he assumed the additional roles that Diana has vacated. This is in addition to his main corporate role as Radio Netherlands' Director of Programmes - Radio, TV and Internet. Clearly he cannot do all these things and continue to produce a weekly show of the high standard that we strive for, and you deserve. So, after much consideration, we've decided that the radio show should end its almost 20 year run while at its listening peak. There has never been more response than we get now. But Media Network, as a "brand", is not disappearing - far from it. Although the radio show will cease to exist, Andy Sennitt will maintain and expand Media Network's web presence. Media Network will be back in the pioneering phase again, looking at new ways to present media news, analysis and background features using the latest Internet technology. Content-wise, Media Network will continue to be 'user driven', but even more so. We'll be adding interactive elements that enable you to react immediately to what you see, hear and read. We'll continue to cover radio and TV developments from longwave right up to the satellite bands, as well as all forms of new media. We'll also be delving into the radio archives of the past two decades and digitizing some of the most memorable features. The final edition of the radio show, on 26 October, is sure to become a collectors' item. In the meantime, after this week's show we'll be repeating the most requested Media Network specials over the

An article from the Catholic broadcaster EWTN reports that Vietnam has been **jamming** Hmong language broadcasts of the Protestant evangelical Far East Broadcasting Company - now known as the Voice of Friendship - from the Philippines. The Hmong are a minority in Vietnam's northeast provinces. Vietnam is worried about the growth of what it calls a "counterrevolutionary Christian movement" among the Hmong people. Thomcast will provide two medium wave transmitters at 800 kilowatts each, three 250-kilowatt shortwave transmitters, and a rotatable shortwave antenna. **Imagination Radio** in Britain is not renewing its one-year contract to broadcast on shortwave. So its final weekly soft-rock show will be Friday September 29th at 1900-2000 UT on 6010. It will continue via satellite or other media. (Communications World Script 16 September 2000, via JKB)

**USA:** On July 31st the U.S. **Armed Forces Radio and Television Service - AFRTS** quit using the Inmarsat satellite service to relay programs to Navy ships. AFN has also been using shortwave for the past year and a half to reach some ships, and that has proven to be an economical alternative to satellite transmissions. In fact, it has been so successful that the Armed Forces Radio will step up its use of Navy single sideband transmitters. This is much like the AFRTS shortwave service of years ago, which used VOA transmitters in regular AM mode. Programming consists of a mix from U.S. domestic commercial and noncommercial networks. A tropical storm has dumped about 48 continuous hours of torrential rains on the Miami area, causing the worst flooding here in many years. It is far worse than Hurricane Irene in October of last year or the flooding caused by Hurricane Andrew in 1992. Streets are flooded, thousands of cars stalled out and abandoned, most access routes to the airport blocked, and many businesses and homes have been flooded with

water. Electrical power and cable TV have been out for thousands of residents. All schools and most businesses were closed on Wednesday (Oct 5), and many will be closed again on Thursday (Oct 6). Water supplies are contaminated. Authorities have advised residents of Miami-Dade County not to venture out of their houses unless they have business of vital importance. Our main office has been inaccessible for the past two days. The storm and flooding have caused several interruptions to *WRMI*'s regular broadcast schedule during the past two days. Our morning transmission to Latin America on 9955 kHz October 5 could not be broadcast as access to the transmitter site was impossible, and the evening transmission on the same day to North America on 7385 kHz could not be broadcast since the floodwaters were over the base of the North American antenna. The evening Latin American transmission on 9955 kHz was expanded to compensate somewhat for the problems. The floodwaters are beginning to go down slowly now, although some additional rain is expected over the next few days. It will likely be at least two or three days (and possibly longer) before things get back to a near normal situation, and during that time it is likely that we will have some additional schedule variations. We had planned to begin testing our new daytime North American frequency of 15725 kHz between 1200-2200 UTC this week, but the flooding has set this back to at least sometime next week (the week of October 9). Thank you for your understanding, and we will attempt to have everything back to normal just as soon as mother nature and our engineering department allow. (Jeff White - WRMI via Marie A. **VATICAN:** *Swiss Radio International* will be using *Vatican Radio* shortwave transmitters as of the B-2000 season beginning October 29th. The Vatican Radio's shortwave transmitters are located near Santa Maria di Galeria, Italy. Most of SRI's transmitters in Switzerland were closed for environmental reasons, so the station must rely on leased facilities in other countries. Monitor report in Vladivostok & Khabarovsk, Russia. I stayed in Russia's Far East city, Vladivostok August 1-8, and heard local LW-MW radios there as follows:

\* Moreover, in Vladivostok, I could listen to the stations in Ussuriysk (R.Ussuri-1269, Evropa Plyus, Ussuriysk-1503) & Nakhodka (R.Nakhodka-684, R.Svobodnaya Nakhodka-1584).

\* I visited HQ of Primorskoe Radio. No one knew "Tikhiy Okean" lost SW transmission there. In communist era, Tikhiy Okean was very prestigious px because of its worldwide broadcast. More than 10 staffs employed for the px. But after the collapse of Soviet Union, the number of the staffs has been reduced. Now only 4 persons manage to make the px.

During my stay in Far East Russia, I made an excursion to Khabarovsk on August 5. Of course I tried to monitor local radios there. Khabarovsk-Vladivostok is half a day trip on sleeper train.
