9690 kHz, on March 8 at 2135 UT, REE playing harpsichord music, unusual, soon YL announcement in Castilian that this is "special programming" because of a strike (huelga) for International Women's Day; more variety of music fill, partly classical, flamenco, etc., never any IDs of the music, but REE IDs and repeated "special" announcements. 2200 UT timesignal and right into "Firebird". So it's special in the sense that they are just playing records instead of producing usual programming.

This is // 11940 kHz, but there is different music fill on 12030 kHz, and the fourth frequency, 11685 kHz, is missing. So perhaps a female on strike was responsible for that transmitter, the others safely under male control?

2259 UT recheck, now "Ode to Joy" with Spanish lyrics; 2300 UT still huelga announcement, so presumably no English today either, as I tune out. The REE music hour at 2200 UT had much better signal than 7490v kHz WBCQ when I was tempted to listen to 'Behaviour Night'.

9690 kHz, REE Noblejas too at 2300 UT in Spanish with time pips and a woman mentioning "programma classical" [sic] and classical instrumentals to a man with a "Radio Exterior de Espana" ID at 2303 UT and into folk vocals with Spanish guitar accompaniment - Very Good Mar 8 - The English program, listed as Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 2300 UT, was missing today. I haven't been listening on Fridays so I have no idea if its missing is a mistake, a change in schedule, or how it's been all along.

WWV & WWVH News Update
DOD Provisional Timeslot on WWV and WWVH.

WWV is going into the military broadcast business (sorta)? We found below this morning on the US Army MARS Facebook Page:

>From April 20 to 3 May, WWV and WWVH will broadcast a DOD message at 10 minutes past the hour on WWV and at 50 minutes past the hour on WWVH.

This April-May time period coincides with the Vital Connection interoperability exercise being held in Wisconsin. Future timeslots will coincide with the Vital Connection exercise Ohio in June; DOD COMEX 19-3 in Aug and the DOD COMEX 19-4 in Oct.

Following the proof of concept this year, we anticipate that the DOD broadcast time slot will become year-round full time. As mentioned above future broadcast may occur prior to selected DOD and Northcom exercises.

This broadcast timeslot will voice announce upcoming exercises and how the amateur radio community can become involved in various exercises. To begin, the broadcast messages will likely be static...future exercises we hope to be able to update the broadcast throughout the exercise as notional conditions change.

The broadcast message will ask listeners to provide reception reports and feedback to a specified URL.

Tune into WWV/H on 2.5, 5, 10, 15, and 20 MHz and submit a reception report and requested feedback.

And in a related WWV event this report in a recent ARRL Newsletter:

WWV Centennial Special Event Will Use WW0WWV.

With its funding secure for another year, WWV, the world's oldest continuously operating radio station, will have extra reason to celebrate its centennial this fall. The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) and the Northern Colorado Amateur Radio Club (NCARC) have teamed up to organize 100th-anniversary events. A memorandum of understanding is pending.

The WWV Committee has announced that the call sign WW0WWV was granted on February 23 to the WWV Amateur Radio Club for use during the Amateur Radio special event, planned to run September 28 - October 2,

with operators on the air around the clock. NCARC predicts the effort will require "hundreds" of volunteer operators.

"The 100th anniversary is an occasion to celebrate radio and our understanding of the electromagnetic spectrum, and an opportunity to help people everywhere appreciate what radio does in their everyday lives," said Dave Swartz, WODAS, who has been spearheading the on-the-air event.

The WWV Committee met on February 22, with representatives of NCARC and NIST on hand, to further firm up plans for the centennial celebratory events. Although the US government cannot fund any Amateur Radio special event expenses, club members will be allowed to use a 15-acre parcel on WWV property, Swartz has explained. The operating site lies outside the security fence.

For its part, NIST will focus on plans for an October 1 recognition ceremony and an open house at the radio station north of Fort Collins. Teak Publishing, Brasstown-NC.

U.S.A. / CZECH REPUBLIC - The United States is reducing the budget of Radio Liberty (Radio Free Europe) for fiscal year 2020 by about 5%, to \$ 628 million.

This was announced after the publication of the draft budget of the Department of State. According to RIA Novosti, the budget of the US agency for global media, which includes radio stations, will be reduced by \$ 33 million. At the same time, the Russian-speaking audience is planned to double. On March 11, the head of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), Mark Green, promised that the United States would propose a mechanism to counter Russia's influence in Europe, Eurasia, and Central Asia in the coming weeks. On the same day, US President Donald Trump, in a budget request to Congress for the 2020 fiscal year (starting October 1), asked for \$ 500 million to counter "Russian malicious influence" in Europe. iz.ru

Of course I wanted to check this out, as it is one of my favorite stations, so tuned in expecting the previous schedule/format to still be the same. Not so!

In past years 0240-0250 UT was always the IS of the call of the African fish eagle, but March 22, tuned in at 0232 UT, to hear repetitive, non-stop pop African music already here; 0253 UT, cut off audio and only heard a loud hum, till 0257 UT hum off; African singing; 0300 UT, here is the IS of the African fish eagle, but played not for ten minutes, but only for about one minute; in vernacular; 0401 UT, brief IS and music before the news; later checked at 0420 UT, only to find they were off the air (earlier than their former sign off time). Clearly needs more monitoring to tell what the regular schedule/format will be. Great to have them back again!

Seeing as 5915 kHz is reactivated, wanted to see if there was any chance that Radio Two/ZNBC2, which has been silent for a long time now, had also come back to life; checking 6165 kHz, from 0240+ UT, but didn't hear anything underneath Cuba.
