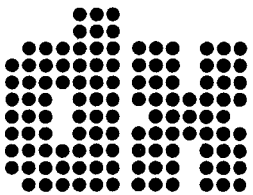

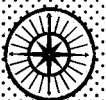

Voice of America (VOA) on 13 July announced that it is ending its radio service in Bangla that served Bangladesh and the Indian states of West Bengal, Assam and Tripura for 63 years. The FM and shortwave radio transmissions of VOA in Bangla would officially end on 17 July, according to a media release. But the service's television and social media content will expand considerably, as these platforms are more heavily used by VOA Bangla's 16 million weekly audience members.

"When VOA Bangla was launched in January 1958, Bangladesh was known as 'East Pakistan' and it was a territory under martial law with no television or private radio," said John Lippman, Acting VOA Programming Director. While the service's shortwave radio audience is now less than 1%, VOA Bangla social media audiences have grown significantly in recent years.

"VOA Bangla radio broadcasts brought world events to its audiences since the days when radio was the primary news medium", Acting VOA Bangla Service Chief Satarupa Barua said. She added, "It was a staple in our upbringing, a household name. We will build on that reputation, increasing our presence on media that is now far more heavily used than short wave and medium wave radio".

Romania: A listener asked the German Service of Radio Romania International how the QSL motifs are chosen. In the mailbox service of 6. June 2021, Sorin Georgescu passed on some interesting information: "The selection of the motifs is made in the so-called General Secretariat, which is made up of the superior of the foreign services in Romanian, that of the services in foreign languages and the Secretary General. One tries to enter into partnerships that firstly make sense and secondly also enable partial financing or sponsorship of the respective series. For example, this year's QSL series is dedicated to the landmarks of the northwest Romanian city of Oradea - the city is also called Großwardein in German, Nagyvarad in Hungarian, in the Middle Ages it was called Magnovaradinum in Latin, probably a Latinized derivation from the Hungarian word vár for castle or fortress. The word 'big' was still present in the older Romanian name, namely Oradia Mare. Today it is the county capital of Bihor County, and, since inter alia. There is also a Slovak minority in the region, it also has a Slovak name with the same meaning: Veľký Varadín. The QSL series was brought out with the support of the city, which hopes that it will also provide some advertising for tourism. The 2020 QSL series was dedicated to old Romanian coins and banknotes - made possible thanks to the support of the

Romanian National Bank. And - to give an older example: The QSL series from 2011 consisted of the photocopying of watercolors by the painter Vitalie Butescu, who came from Moldova, which in turn depicted monuments from Bucharest and the surrounding area. The artist allowed us to reproduce and publish his works as postcards and in return certainly hoped that his paintings would become popular abroad." (Google translation) (HB)
