

ALGERIA - Algerian Radio has started testing from their new SW sites at Ouargla and/or Bechar, where installation of new 300 kW Ampegon transmitters has been underway for several years to cover the Sahel region.

>>> TDA facebook <<< page reported yesterday (21 July) that technicians at Berkaoui (near Ouargla) are preparing for the launch of the new SW centre there.

Radio Algiers heard since tune-in at 1600 UT today July 23 on 15340 kHz with low audio modulation, also noted since 2045 UT tune-in in // on 15100 kHz with a much stronger signal and better audio. Programming mosting in Arabic, with some French. Currently (at 2110 UT) 15100 and 15340 kHz are in parallel with the web feed of Radio Algerie Chaine 1 in Arabic.

The schedule so far does not reflect HFCC request registrations. The registered schedule also includes the relays via Issoudun (France): ">http://hfcc.org/data/schedbybrc.php?seas=A22

Re: RTA Bechar and Qurgla sites on test?

Nothing else than http://hfcc.org/data/schedbybrc.php?seas=A22&broadc=TDA is available so far, besides the unspecific announcement of testing, or?

Frequencies are used also widely outside these hours, so it's perhaps really a good idea to not take the site usage shown therein as granted. What can be made out is that one transmitter suffers from a squeal and somewhat low modulation. It probably stays always on 15340 kHz so far, where it operates also widely outside the shown 0700-1100 UT slot, like now, around 1900 UT. The other transmitter is on air now as well, this time on 17600 kHz which happens to be registered for use at this hour.

What does not match at all are the frequency selections and the given target areas. Bechar was originally supposed to serve Libya, Niger and Chad and the visible alignment of the really built antenna pair would fit.

Qurgla was once described as serving West Africa, in this case the antennas are not visible in Google Maps yet. For both target areas perhaps already 19 metres but at least 16 metres stretches the limits even during daytime. After 1900 UT, i.e. after sunset in Algeria, they are certainly too high for the originally stated purpose.

Perhaps it is at this point mere equipment testing and it does not matter at all whether or not the transmissions can actually be received anywhere. But so far these tests raise more new questions than they answer ...

And allow me to repeat the question about the co-located longwave outlets. Has any installation of TRAM gear taken place there (not talking about the separate 576 kHz building at Bechar {of went bankrupt TransRadio Berlin firm four years ago), or come the new signs of live on 153 kHz still from the old (Thomson-CSF I understand) tube transmitters? (Kai Ludwig-D, WOR July 26)

"Radio Nacional de Angola, 4949.7 kHz on air after months without detecting it Manuel Mendez, Lugo, Spain, Log in Reinante, NW of Spain, Tecsun PL-880, cable antenna, 8 meters: ANGOLA 4949.7, Radio Nacional de Angola, Mulenvos, 1956-2016 UT on July 14, comments, songs. Strong carrier, extremely weak audio, barely audible, best on LSB."

Tropical Bands Monitor as of 1 July shows this on 4949.7 kHz had been reported this year only in January and March. Once upon a time RNA ran allnight and its off-frequency carrier at least could be detected in deep North America. As of last year, WRTH showed 4950 kHz as 24 hrs with {national wb.} A program in Portuguese, nominal 25 kW; while MW 945 kHz had some foreign languages local evenings. (wh, wor July 15)

Diaz-Canel congratulates Cuba's radio on its 100th anniversary Havana, Aug 22 (Prensa Latina) President Miguel Diaz-Canel on Monday congratulated producers and listeners on the occasion of the centenary of Cuban radio. On his Twitter, the president wished "that for the next 100 years it will continue sounding with the Cuban spirit that distinguishes it".

With the beginning of radio transmissions on August 22, 1922, Cuba was among the first countries in Latin America to have this kind of communication. The accelerated development of the medium allowed that less than a year later 24 transmitting stations were registered, including 14 in Havana. By the end of 1923, that number rose to 31 radio stations throughout the country.

The creation of Radio Rebelde in the mountains of the Sierra Maestra, on February 24, 1958, marked the beginning of the National Radio System, which has focused on the dissemination of knowledge, culture, recreation and the ideological, social, ethical and aesthetic values of the Cuban people.

Cuban radio began its first digital transmission in 1998. Today, the 97 digital radio stations produce their own contents. (via Mike Cooper-Atlanta-GA-USA, Aug 22)

Lithuania will start broadcasting a Russian-language, Netherlands-registered radio station, Radio Pravda, which will be accessible to audiences in Russia, Belarus, and elsewhere.

"These are broadcasts for Russian-speaking audiences, the waves travel far, and the programme is broadcast from 20:00 to midnight," Valdas Kaminskas, a spokesperson for the Lithuanian Radio and Television Centre (Telecentras), told BNS.

"The broadcasts are aimed against disinformation, against war, to compensate for Russia's anti-Ukrainian propaganda", he added. The programme will be picked up as far as Siberia, Central Asia and Kazakhstan, according to Kaminskas.

Radio Pravda will be broadcast from Sitkunai in central Lithuania. The Sitkunai radio station originally came online in 1950 and then played a major role during the January 1991 events. In their attempts to topple the Lithuanian government, which had declared in March 1990, Soviet troops occupied the Lithuanian Radio and Television building and the TV Tower in Vilnius. ...

On Friday 5 August at 17.00 UTC, "Radio Pravda" started broadcasting on AM 1557 kHz from Sitkunai in Lithuania. The station, also known as "Nasha Lenta" (Our Band), provides independent information in Russian to Russia and Belarus and is fully funded by private donors.

Its programmes are under the supervision of the Dutch Media Commission. Radio Pravda received permission from the Commissariat and its programmes are compiled in the Netherlands before being transmitted to Lithuania for rebroadcasting on AM 1557 kHz. The Lithuanian authorities in turn issued a 'retransmission licence'.

There are no political motives and no involvement of any government, not even financial. "The only thing that matters is the free flow of uncensored, verified information to Russia and Belarus."

The transmitter used in Lithuania is the Nautel RX50 which was previously used by Big L on AM 1395 kHz from Trintelhaven in the Netherlands, in an attempt to reach a daytime audience in England. Later this transmitter was used on 1008 kHz to broadcast the religious station Groot Nieuws Radio. Since the 1008 kHz was closed down, the transmitter was stored in the Netherlands. The past few weeks a lot of work was done to get the full 50 kilowatts on the air on AM 1557 kHz. This also required a new antenna design.

The results are phenomenal. The signal on AM 1557 kHz can be received well at night throughout Europe. There is a strong night signal in cities like Saint-Petersburg, Moscow and Minsk and it also covers the whole territory of the Ukraine. Even on Russia's border with Norway in the Arctic, the signal is still quite good, as well as in Novosibirsk, which is some 1,500 kilometres from the transmitter site.

Cuban Radio broadcasting celebrates 100th anniversary by Jorge Ruiz Miyares

One hundred years ago the first experimental radio broadcast took place in Cuba.

On August 22, 1922, the sound of radio astonished at 9:00 p.m. when the first Cuban station, 2LC, began broadcasting.

Its founder, Luis Casas Romero, composer, flutist, orchestra conductor, and cultural promoter, along with his children, premiered it on an experimental basis. The occasion is considered on the island, the advent of the radio broadcasts era.

In remarks to primetime Radio, Haciendo Radio, President Miguel Diaz-Canel Bermudez acknowledged the importance of the medium, which despite new technologies, the explosion of social media, and the Internet, remains a primary source of information, as the medium with the most extensive reach.

He said that in Cuba, people remain identified with their local radio stations, and he recalled programs that remain part and parcel of everyday life on the island.

In his remarks to Haciendo Radio, Diaz-Canel congratulated radio personnel, producers, and listeners and expressed his wishes that over the next century, radio broadcasting on the island continues to sound with the Cubanness that distinguishes it.

Radio NUG - The Voice of National Unity Government of Myanmar

The Voice of Myanmar Spring Revolution & National Unity Government of Myanmar was founded in August 24th 2021, under the guidance of National Unity Government's Ministry of Communications, Information & Technology.

It is broadcasting on shortwave daily in Burmese at 02.00-02.30 UTC on 17790 kHz and 14.00-14.30 UTC on 11940 kHz (250 kW from Paochung/Taiwan).

The station plans to cover the National Unity Government (NUG); human rights abuses allegedly perpetrated by the junta; and the civil disobedience movement, a pro-democracy campaign that leads anti-coup protests around the country.

The NUG is a shadow government made up of members of the ousted National League for Democracy, activists and others from ethnic minorities. It was formed after the military claimed control in a February coup, ousted the democratically elected leadership and arrested senior politicians.

The NUG does not officially run the radio channel, but it is providing guidance to supporters who set up the station, according to Htin Linn Aung, the NUG minister of communications, information and technology.

"We [the NUG] have to let them know what we are doing - how we are trying to restore democracy in Burma," Aung, who is living in the United States, told VOA. Burma is another name for Myanmar.

Myanmar's military leaders outlawed the station on the day it first broadcast. The junta's Ministry of Information issued a statement in state media saying that those working with or supporting Radio NUG "will have action taken against them in accordance with the law."


