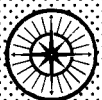
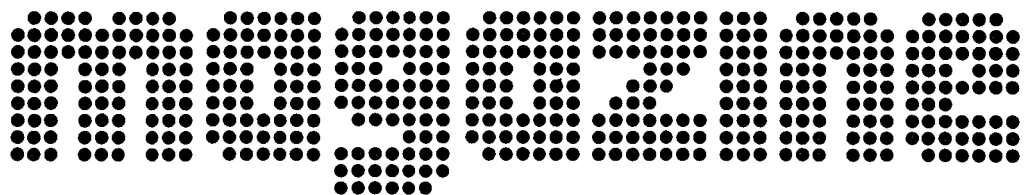
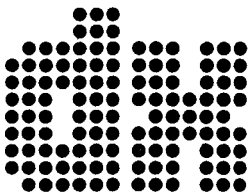

ALGERIA - 5900 kHz March 17 at 0633 UT, S=9+20/30dB of Qur'an, certainly not TOMBS via Bulgaria as has been here. Presumably NF for one of the Algerian sites {most likely Ourgla towards south-western Sahel / WeAF target, wb} I vaguely recall they've been on 5900 kHz before, but can't find a report. Soon YL talk in Arabic before more music. Scan of all bands upward to 13 MHz does not find another one to make // . Not on 9500 kHz, so I wonder if accidentally

they reversed the digits? We shall hear if this recur. But 9500 kHz supposedly at 00-06 UT only.

I'm checking 5900 kHz following this from Jim Renfrew, NY, at 0415 UT: "Radio Coran 5900 kHz. Glenn, while attempting to listen to the theological renditions of Brother Stair on 5900 khz from Kostinbrod-Sofia-BUL, on March 17, at 0305 UT, I instead found a Koranic program of some kind - very strong - with Overcomers way underneath (and parallel to 6160v WBCQ). At 0400 UT the 5900 kHz station has a national anthem - familiar, but I can't place it. Ah, there it is, at 0406 UT an English ID "Holy Koran Radio, Algeria" and the same in French, then back to Koranic readings. Frequency appears to be unlisted in WRTH and recent NASWA bulletins.

Seems // to 7440 kHz{from Bechar site towards south-eastern Sahel azi, wb} but weak there and hard to be certain. Brother Stair, tonight (from beyond the grave, I suppose) is all about the appearance of "Planet X" and how the Norwegians have a plan to rescue their population. (gh, hcdx and WOR March 18)

"A partir de este momento transmite LRA 36, Radio Arcangel San Gabriel en onda corta, 15476 kHz, desde Base Esperanza, Antartida Argentina", ID. in various languages, comments in Spanish, "Uniendo Voces, un programa de LRA 36 ...", "Les habla Juan Benavente", "Ecos de la Antartida sera el programa del ciclo 2023". "Desde la Base Esperanza, Antartida Argentina transmite LRA 36, Radio Nacional Arcangel San Gabriel para todo el mundo", at 2129 UT "Los datos del tiempo, sensacion termina -1 grado". 35443 to 45444.

As announced during the transmission, the 2023 season program, which I imagine will start in April, will be called "Ecos de la Antartida", being the current summer program, "Uniendo Voces", a transition to the new program "Ecos de la Antartida". (Manuel Mendez-Lugo-ESP, BrDXC-UK ng March 26)

CUBA - 15140 kHz, March 14 at 1900-1915 UT, checking for RHC English at earliest time, but: no signal here nor on 11760 kHz. Something's always wrong at RHC. 11880 kHz not on air before or after 2230.

RHC website is uselessly outdated, and HFCC is boycotted, but does register with ITU, for A-23 as of 23 February latest: I pull out the higher-band CUB entries. They are all HAB without breaking down to three different sites; the Language column is always blank; and some obvious traditional CRI relays are not marked as such. With kW powers and azimuths which should make the target clear:

GERMANY / U.S.A. - Radio Carpathia has an interesting mix of Eastern European oldies as well as modern pop and rock. It makes a change to hear these tunes that are not generally played in most of the pop/oldies music stations around at the moment.

I listened to the programme on 19 March via Channel 292 [Rohrbach Waal near Ingolstadt in Bavaria], and whilst I'm not especially a fan of the harsher sounds of East European rock/pop, or indeed modern pop, there was much still to appreciate with tracks from Bulgaria, Romania and Ukraine, amongst others.

Radio Carpathia is broadcast on the 3rd Sunday of the month via Channel292 at 1200 UT on 9670 kHz. From 20 March, Radio Carpathia is also new to WRMI at 0200 UT on 5850 kHz for North American listeners on Mondays with a monthly 30-minute cut-down version of the main programme. This Channel One programming is very different from the 7780 kHz, VOI (Channel Two) relay via WRMI USA relay in Florida

at 8-9 UT.

Thanks to the very kind assistance of Bruce Churchill and also to MarcosC. (Chile), who provided info here on WORiog, I have located a good reference for this SW station. The station is operated by the Cotahuasi Ministry Center Project - <<https://quechuamissions.com/peru2>> which page also contains some nice pictures:

"The Cotahuasi Canyon has some of the most rugged country on earth. There are over 40 villages scattered through the canyon and shepherds huts dot the high altitude meadows, some accessible only by hiking or horseback. How are we to share the Gospel with them? How are we to encourage those who are responding?"

One way to reach them is through daily radio broadcasts and the preparation of digital recordings of the scriptures in their local dialects. The Cotahuasi Ministry Center Project now includes the Christian radio station and distribution of digital media players and radios. Supporting this Project supports the Radio Station and other important ministries.

Since May of 2008, Bible teaching via FM radio reaches into many of these communities, proclaiming God's truth and "feeding His sheep" with the Word of God. The Quechua church planters that cannot visit all of the new village churches are now using "Radio Senda Cristiana" (The Christian Way Radio) to supplement church planting and discipleship ministry. We would like to expand our transmitter range using Short Wave, and when complete we expect to reach most of southern Peru with the Gospel in the Quechua and Spanish languages.

Through efforts of the ministry of SonSet Solutions <<https://sonsetsolutions.org/about/>> we receive technical help, resources, and training to enable us to develop and continue on the air.

The prospect of expanding our listening area with the installation of Short Wave Radio is an exciting and important development with the help of SonSet solutions' expertise and resources. Their portable, solarpowered, fixed-frequency radios have been donated and these are a great blessing to enable people to listen to Radio Senda Cristiana.

Being faithful to God's word is essential in the work of radio programming. As we strive to learn more and honor the Lord, please pray that He would guide us in all wisdom and knowledge so that we will be faithful in broadcasting God's word. Also, please pray for wisdom in maintaining the radios and equipment, generators and antennas, and the development of electrical power options for our remote transmitter site."

U.S.A. - 5085 kHz March 21 at 0100 UT, WTTW-2 is still missing, as George McClintock updates me: altho he can operate it remotely, he has been recovering from a virus or something for the past two weeks, quite ill at home - and also a week without power following the windstorm; still trees across the street. Meanwhile the station still needs a *lot* of work; I suspected he was axually somewhat enjoying the troubleshooting, repairing challenges, when he can get to the site.

Says an insulator broke at the end of an antenna wire, called a Steotype, or something like that. #2 transmitter runs at 70 kW, but Ted left with the harmonic filter not working [tho I never heard any second harmonix from it].

Parts to bring the #1 up from 70 to a minimum of 90 kW were ordered and supposed to be shipped from China three weeks ago; follow-up found they were not shipped until last week, so wait another week. Hoping that a sale will go thru but not firm yet. Buyer will gain among everything else, at least twelve high power tubes.

Each transmitter needs only one, but Ted had been running the filaments 24 hours, wearing them down, all of them only partly depleted. Come to think of it, everything was done wrong. George is at least making sure by remote control that the filaments are off when not transmitting. #1 and #3 are in pieces. #3 driver tube is no good.

A fan was cooling a balun, but fan's power was not wired in. A frequency coil was missing, so had to recalibrate. Currently concerned with fixing the automatic gate to the property.

Russian-language broadcast on **Radio Miami International - WRMI**, from Okeechobee, Florida state, USA. The largest private shortwave transmission center in the Western Hemisphere in Okeechobee-FL from 1977 until 2013 belonged to the international religious radio station WYFR-Family Radio / Family Radio, which broadcast for a long time since 1974 and in Russian. It was purchased by commercial radio station WRMI and returned to the air in December 2013. Most airtime is sold to third parties, including currently four Russian-language broadcasters.

Since 2016, the weekly half-hour program "Radiopanorama" of the Russian branch of the World Radio Network WRN (World Radio Network) has been released, since 2022 - the weekly half-hour program "Kaleidoscope" of the same broadcaster.

Since 2021, the weekly half-hour program "Your Story Hour" has switched to WRMI from the closed radio station WHRI-World Harvest Radio, which had previously aired there for more than 10 years. The radio ministry, and then the eponymous organization Your Story Hour / "Hour of Your Story", engaged in staged audio recording and distribution of recorded programs, has existed in the United States since 1949 and is located in the city of Berrien Springs, Michigan.
