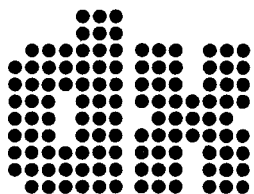

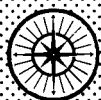

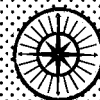

Hello again,

Welcome to another issue of our DX MAGAZINE. I have no news to report from inside the club this month - therefore let's just start with our usual news from outside the club:

Hörfunk-Legende **Hans Werner Lange** ist tot. Er starb am 04. Mai 2023 im Alter von 84 Jahren nach kurzer, schwerer Krankheit in seiner Heimatstadt Duisburg.

Lange begann seine Radiokarriere Mitte der sechziger Jahre. Sein Markenzeichen war schon damals die prägnante, tiefe, aber warme Stimme, mit der er Generationen von Hörerinnen und Hörern begeisterte. Nach seiner Zeit bei Radio Luxemburg und der Europawelle Saar wechselte er zur Deutschen Welle. Über viele Jahre hinweg war Lange für den deutschsprachigen Auslandsdienst der NBC in Namibia tätig. Noch bis ins hohe Alter produzierte er Sendungen und Beiträge für die Station in Windhuk.



2008 kam Lange als Moderator zu RADIO700. Er prägte das tägliche Nachrichtenmagazin "Feierabend", das er bis Anfang Mai täglich von Montag bis Freitag zwischen 16 und 19 Uhr moderierte. Deshalb galt er zuletzt als "Deutschlands ältester amtierender Moderator mit einem täglichen Hörfunkeinsatz". Daneben war Lange auch für viele Unterhaltungssendungen bei RADIO700 am Mikrofon. Über mehrere Jahre moderierte er die "Oldiethek". Kultstatus beim Publikum erreichte auch seine jährliche Sendung am Abend des 24. Dezember, wo er besonders einfühlsam und mit bewegenden Worten und Geschichten die Hörer Jahr für Jahr ins Weihnachtsfest begleitete. Allein bei RADIO700 war Hans-Werner Lange für mehr als 4.000 Sendungen im Einsatz.

Auch für unser Hobby hat Hans Werner Lange einen großen Beitrag geleistet: 35 Jahre produzierte Hans Werner die ADDX-Programme über Radio HCJB und die KBS DX-Tipps. Auch für den RTI-Hörerklub Ottenau hat er viele Jahre deren "RTI DX-Tipps" in seinem Studio aufgenommen.

**ALGERIA** - 9455 kHz April 19 at 0400 UT, RTA Arabic playing martial national anthem, but no English ID by 0405 UT as before following NA; back into Arabic, and Qur'an; break circa 0430 UT more talk before resuming Qur'anic. This continues from previous report about this colliding with reactivated WRMI, worse on receivers further west.

9455 kHz April 19 at \*0303 UT, RTA Bechar cuts on with Qur'an in progress. But WRMI has just reactivated this frequency, q.v. From 0250 or 0255 I'm standing by via University EnschedeTwente-HOL, Maryland and Missouri SDRs. At UTwente there has been a VP signal from WRMI, but now Legends is totally overridden by Qur'anic, S=9+20dB, making a slow SAH as both are close to .000. At Maryland, RTA is S6/S8 but well atop RMI. At Missouri, RMI rules, but we can hear Qur'an underneath, what a culture clash.

Only Aoki shows RTA on 9455 kHz at 0300-0600 UT; EiBi database shows 9470 & 9500 kHz but neither is on now. (gh, hcdx and WOR April 13 - 19 )

13790 kHz Tue, Apr 18, 0146-0200 UT, RTA Radio Algerienne, Ouargla-ALG in Arabic. Holy Qur'an program this Ramadan: Chant. Good reception: 45554.

17600 kHz Tue, Apr 18, 2019-2030 UT, RTA Radio Algerienne, Bechar-ALG, in Arabic. The Ramadan Koranic chants. Fair to poor reception: 45433 to 45422. (Jota Xavier-Cabedelo-PB\_BRA, WOR April 18)

I have been following the new African station Ifriky FM from Algeria, and recorded 13590 and 13790 kHz overnight from 2300 to 0300 UT (6 May into 7 May). There was overall good reception on 13790 kHz (via Ourgla), with audible but weaker reception on 13590 kHz (via Bechar). Programming was predominantly African music, however there was a female host from 2325 UT and later a male host, with various guests with short speech segments.

From around 0255 UT there was a promo loop with a montage of voices mentioning Burkino Faso and Sudan perhaps others) which could have been journalists covering those areas. Seems to me that the station is in "preview" mode and has yet to settle down to regular programming. Worth keeping a watch on.

28 Nov 2022 though 2 Dec 2022 - my own detailed survey over a few days shows 5025 kHz Rebelde off the air, and 4765 kHz on the air, - but irregularly so.

04 Dec 2022 last reported log of 4765 kHz found in the DX press.

24 Dec 2022 5025 kHz Rebelde directly observed back on the air again, initially irregular but later consistent, but with greatly deteriorated audio like 4765 kHz. 4765 kHz was never heard again.

5025 kHz continues active now, and 4765 kHz continues inactive.

Thus, my theory that the former 4765 kHz transmitter, presumed Bejucal, is now used for 5025 kHz. That suggests the destruction of 5025 kHz at the former, nominal Bauta site by hurricane Ian.

Any statement that Radio Progreso still transmits from Bejucal is now incorrect.

S=9+10/20dB and only -1.6 Hz into Missouri SDR with high storm noise level. After some music, full traditional ID at 0130UT as "Radio Progreso, La Onda de la Alegria". Rebelde is also on now, 5025 kHz about same signal at S=9+10/25dB.

Richard Langley, NewBrunswik-CAN, had reported to WOR iog: "Last night (UT 7 May) around 0140UT, 5025 and 4765 kHz both were on with good signals here in NB but 4765 kHz was QRMed by a strong utility signal (CODAR?). Nothing heard on 5040 kHz. Richard Langley"

4765 kHz nominal sked presuably still only 0030-0400 UT.

**DENMARK** - World Music Radio (WMR) has commenced using a new 300 Watts transmitter from April 12 2023 on 15700 kHz after several months with 10 Watts only here. The transmitter is currently being run on a test basis 24/7 hrs/d - but from next week it will be Saturdays and Sundays only. Occasionally on weekdays (I can put the transmitter on - by request, should anyone want it). So far results have been good. The signals has been monitored via KiwiSDRs in South Africa, Kenya, Argentina, Brazil, Bonaire, USA, Iceland, Russia, Ireland, many places in Central and South Europe, the Middle East, Australia and New Zealand.

The aerial is a three element yagi beamed south. The transmitter is slightly off channel (a bit below 15700.0 kHz); this will be adjusted as soon as possible. Works will also be done to improve the audio quality on 15700 kHz.

WMR is still on the air on 927 kHz (150 Watts), 5930 kHz (100 Watts), and 25800 kHz (60 Watts). These three frequencies are on the air 24/7 hrs/d.

Power on 5930 kHz will soon be increased to 200 Watts. In the last few months 25800 kHz has been monitored almost all over the WORld - at times - due to the current high sunspot numbers.

Radio208 has had some issues with a new 300 Watts transmitter on 5970 kHz - replacing the old 100 Watts transmitter, which was running around 75 Watts only. The new transmitter has been on and off for the past few weeks. It was put back into service again today at 10 UT, the power lowered to 200 Watts, and hopefully it will continue now. Later, plans are to improve the dipole aerial for 5970 kHz, and thus increase power to 300 Watts again.

Also problems with the aerial for 1440 kHz. Currently 1440 is running low power (around 20-30 Watts), so still audible locally. It may take a couple of weeks until 1440 kHz can return to full power, which may be 500 Watts instead of the 'normal' 400 Watts. We are considering a new aerial, which would improve reception in central Copenhagen. Both 5970 kHz and 1440 kHz are on the air 24/7.

I am very late sending out QSL's. Sorry ! The new WMR 2023 QSL is currently being designed, and will hopefully be ready by the end of the month. Kindly - please - notice that reports using remote receivers are not wanted, and they are not QSLed. E-QSLs are free of charge of course, but if a printed QSL card is desired, kindly send five Euro - or two IRCs to cover return postage. Donations are always VERY welcome. Address is:

India's government [Nationalist Hindu party] has ordered its public broadcaster, All India Radio (AIR) to be exclusively referred to as Akashvani in all broadcasts from now on. Akashvani, which means 'voice from the sky' was a name proposed by Nobellaureate Rabindranath Tagore in a poem he had written for the inauguration of the Calcutta shortwave service in 1939. However, since 1956 both names have been used in the broadcasts.

AIR began its journey on June 8 1936, when the British government renamed the Indian Broadcasting Company. The Akashvani name was added in 1956. In a satellite message on May 3, relayed from the policy division of the office of the director general, Akashvani, to all centres across the country, the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (I&B) has decided to enforce a provision of the law by which the radio vertical of Prasar Bharati will now be called only Akashvani.

On Wednesday, the English morning news bulletin broadcast at 8.15 am carried the All India Radio name in its introduction. But by the afternoon news bulletin, broadcast at 4.05 pm, the announcer had switched to Akashvani.

Akashvani's home service comprises 470 broadcasting centres located across the country and broadcasts in 23 languages and 179 dialects, covering 92 per cent of the country's area and 99.19 per cent of the total population. The new announcement pattern will be followed in other languages or dialects as well.

The Prasar Bharati (Broadcasting Corporation of India) Act, 1990, mentions that 'Akashvani' means the offices, stations and other establishments, by whatever name called, which, immediately before the appointed day, formed part of or were under the Director-General, All India Radio of the Union Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. The Prasar Bharati Act came into force on November 15, 1997.

"This was long pending and in line with the law which came into being in 1997. Our listeners have more of a connect with Akashvani and so we are ridding ourselves of colonial baggage that may have persisted," said Gaurav Dwivedi, Chief Executive Officer of Prasar Bharati, which is the parent organisation of Akashvani. **UNITED KINGDOM / GERMANY** - SCOTTISH RADIO STATION CELEBRATES 60th ON SW AND MW. On 6th June 1963, four schoolchildren gathered in the attic of a house on the Ardrossan seafront in Ayrshire to launch their very own radio station. Cobbled together with tins, clockwork gramophones, and lots of wire, the opening day's programmes were line fed to a radio receiver two floors down. But it was a start and, against the odds, the station survived in a variety of forms and today can be heard 24/7 on the internet. With listeners in 208 countries, and both daily direct FM and regular shortwave rebroadcasts as well as a network of 30 affiliate AM, FM and Digital stations around the world, radio six international is a force to be reckoned with.

Programming is largely unsigned and indie performers worldwide, while at weekends a team of some 30 seasoned professionals provide specialist music programming. The station is now based in a purpose-built headquarters on the Inner Hebridean island of Lismore, a tiny island sandwiched between Oban on the mainland and the much bigger island of Mull to the west.

To celebrate the station's 60th anniversary on 6th June 2023, a day of original programmes from all the current station presenters will be broadcast, with the entire 24 hours carried on 9,670kHz in the 31 metre band from Röhrbach in Germany, as well as from FM transmitters in New Zealand on 88.2 and 107.6MHz between 00:00 and 23:59 GMT. And as well as the streaming at <<http://www.radiosix.com>> (Alexa, "play radio six international") the two hour live special programme "Sixty Swinging Years" hosted by Tony Currie will air on 1,323kHz from the Nexus-IBA transmitter in Milan, Italy between 19:00 and 21:00 GMT. A special QSL card will be issued for the occasion and reception reports are encouraged.
