AUSTRIA - 6055 kHz Sunday only 09.00-10.00 UT Radio DARC - German amateur club radio society program, radio news and rock/pop music programme, at 09.50 UT June 11, S=9+40dB powerhouse 100 kW signal from ORS Moosbrunn bcast relay transmission center. 10 kHz wideband audio signal, // also via hobby stn ch292 Waal on 6070, S=3 -114dBm poor signal.

BOTSWANA - 17530 kHz VOA English, 1515z, June 18. DJ style music program with two guys talking about the artists and music. Not Willis Conover but not bad at all. Program off at 1600z.HFCC shows 100kW at 10degree directed to ITU zones 46,47, 52, 53 and 57 (includes all of Sub Saharan Africa plus Madagascar) using a type 156 curtain (2 wide X 4 high) which should offer about a 50degree half power beamwidth. Most of the target area is within about 3000 miles with mainly West Africa receiving a diminishing signal outside of the primary beam. West Africa is really more appropriately covered by Sao Tome anyway, which has beams that put the target areas in West Africa no more than 1500 to 2000 miles distant. Selebi-Phikwe to central Texas is about 9000 miles at an azimuth of 293degrees with an all daylight path for about another hour. Selebi-Phikwe sunset at 1733 local (1533z). This month's cover, prepared by John Herkimer, shows some active Peruvian shortwave stations: Radio Tarma operating on 4775 kHz from Tarma, Junin; Radio Quillabamba, 5025 kHz, Quilla-bamba, Cusco; Radio Logos, 4810 kHz, Chazuta, Tarapoto; and Radio Huanta 2000, 4750 kHz, Huanta, Ayacucho.

Also shown is the new Peruvian station, Radio Senda Cristiana, 4820 kHz, from Cotahuasi, Arequipa. (See the May 2023 Journal for Bryan Clark's excellent article, "DX Detectives at Work!" about the discovery of the station, reprinted from the New Zealand DX Times.) SINGAPORE / OMAN - BBC Singapore/Oman relay center matter. The latest HFCC registration file dated 21 June 2023 shows some new Oman frequencies for the BBC starting on 15 July. They appear to be planned as replacements for transmissions that currently come from Singapore Kranji site, which would somewhat support recent rumours about a pending closure of the Singapore relay site. The Singapore registrations have not been modified (their end date is still given as 29 Oct), but that may happen later.

New Oman frequencies starting 15 July:

9550 1700-1900 Dari and Pashto, possibly replacing the Singapore outlet currently on 11735 kHz.

11685 1300-1400 English, currently in use by Singapore.

11995 1400-1700 Dari and Pashto, currently in use by Singapore.

17515 1330-1400 Burmese, possibly replacing one of the Singapore outlets, currently on 7465 and 9585 kHz. >>> The remaining registered Singapore frequencies are not affected (yet).

The easiest explanation for such a scenario would be a reduction in staffing. These old transmitters need manual intervention, at least for frequency changes where, if they are not confined to within the same band, even heavy components have to be wheeled out and in.

But I would first wait if perhaps further bookings on third party facilities have just not been posted yet and the appearance of this Oman data is indeed the first sign of an imminent closure. (Kai Ludwig-D, hcdx & WOR June 26)

This could be a phased shutdown of the Singapore Kranji facility as its transmitters are taken out of service and broadcasts transferred elsewhere. It's also possible that the remaining transmissions are simply discontinued.

Kai Ludwig had speculated that the station was already being dismantled. Note that between 8am and 6pm local time

in Singapore there are only two hours of transmissions: the 01 UT beam to South Asia on 17790 kHz, and the DRM mode broadcast at 08 UT on 17720 kHz. This would allow for work being done on the station closure.

The Singapore relay has been operating at less than 13% of its total time capacity, so extremely inefficient to continue. (Stephen Luce, Houston-TX-USA, hcdx & WOR June 25)

Keith Perron of PCJ Media recently visited Singapore. Whilst there Keith visited the BBC Far East Relay station at Kranji and provides us with audio tour of the station with two station staff employees.

During Keith's visit to the station he mentions that the Media Corp shortwave transmitters, equipment and antennas were all scrapped and dumped. This confirms what I was told my a Media Corp employee 3 or 4 months ago. What is absolutely astonishing, as Keith mentions, is that the staff at the adjoining BBC Kranji site were not even offered the MediaCorp shortwave broadcasting equipment before it was scrapped and dumped. It was equipment which is much newer than that used at the BBC/Babcock site. The staff at the Babcock site would have jumped at the opportunity of being offered some of the equipment, Keith was told. This is just another in a long line of bewildering decisions made by some radio broadcasters out there concerning shortwave broadcasting and transmission equipment.

28 Atlantic 2000 International, since 1982 on shortwave

After broadcasting on FM from 1978 to 1982, Atlantic 2000 International was heard for the first time on shortwave on June 6th, 1982 on 7325 kHz. They were on the air usually every month until July 1988. The first transmission equipment was a home-made 25 W valves transmitter. In 1984, they built a 30 W transmitter. After more than 19 years of silence, Atlantic 2000 International was back on the air on October 28th, 2007 on 6280 and 6210 kHz. From 2008 to 2010, they broadcasted from Italy, by using the transmitters of Mystery Radio and Radio Amica.

From December 2010, they transmitted from Germany, via several relay stations:

- on 3985, 6005 and 7310 kHz via Shortwave Service in Kall-Krekel (12/2010 to 02/2017)
- on 9480, 9485 and 7265 kHz via MV Baltic Radio in Göhren (10/2011 to 01/2016)
- on 3955, 6070, 7440 and 9670 kHz via Channel 292 in Rohrbach Waal.

In July 2016 and January 2018, Atlantic 2000 International was relayed by WINB, from Red Lion in the USA, with a power of 50 kW on 9265 kHz.

In 2021, a part of the program were transmitted by WRMI - Radio Miami International from the Okeechobee site in Florida, USA, with a power of 100 kW.

Since the beginning of the shortwave transmissions, Atlantic 2000 International received a lot of reception reports from Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belarus, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Morocco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine, United Kingdom, Uruguay, USA, Venezuela and more countries via direct reception or via several web receivers in Europe and USA.
