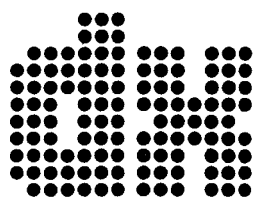

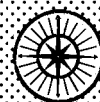

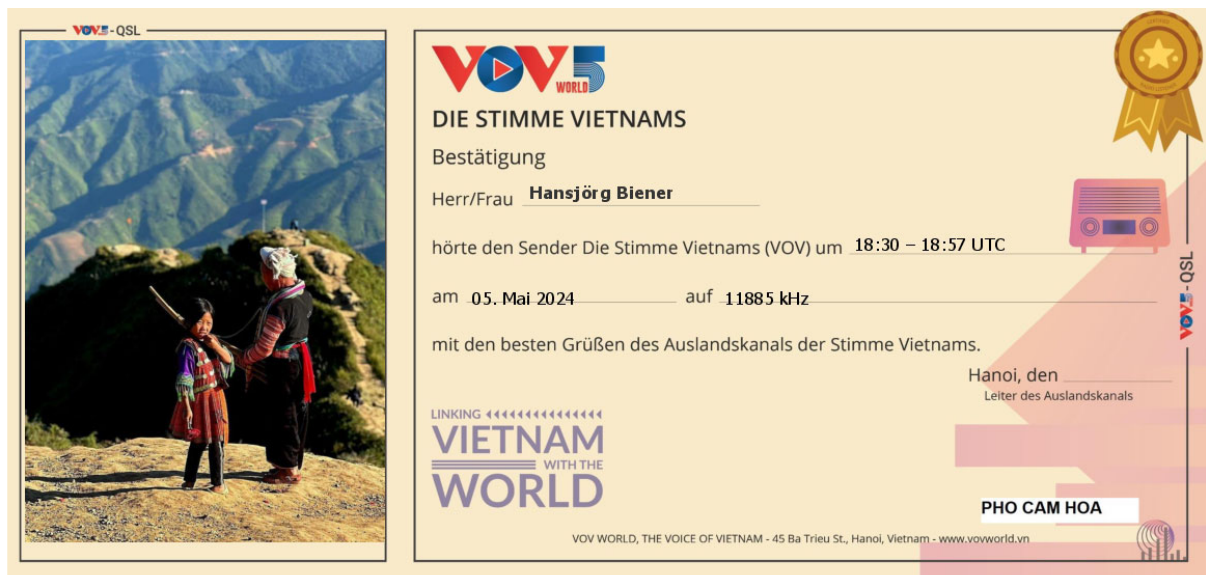

ALASKA - 9695 kHz KNLS, 0800-0815 UT on 29 May, English sce. Sign on at 0800 UT "From the top of the world, this is your new life station, broadcasting on KNLS, Anchor Point Alaska, USA ... Our English language transmission starts in one minute". After IS, further ID welcoming listeners to "the English hour bringing you the music of our time and the message for all time". Lucy Grant and Rob Scobie as host with rundown of show. Mix of music news, secular music, and bible lessons. Very good.

ALGERIA - 17599.998 kHz on May 15 at 1738 UT, Ifrikya FM, S8/9+5dB of music we think of as 'Horn of Africa' but this is not from the Horn; have also heard the style well inland into Sudan/South e.g. I shall keep an ear on it via UTwente for some English to come: not at 1803 UT, just music still at 1808 UT; French ID at 1814 UT; 1820-1825 UT

brief floating English segment: about Nigeria (not Algeria) economic problems, naira, IMF, etc.

YL has a good accent but speaks too fast making her hard to follow; also some overmodulation distortion and annoying continuous music mixing. I suspect that some ESL speakers try to impress us with their fluency by speaking as rapidly as possible rather than aiming for clarity. Gives her name and "signing off" already at 1824 UT; then ID in English, "from north to south, east to west" with FM frequencies 105.6, 98.7, 93.2, 89.9 in different cities including Oran, 1825 UT back to music and French talk segments past 1854 UT.

Adventist World Radio - The remaining operation of shortwave broadcasting in Austria

Two decades after Radio Österreich International was discontinued - which no one would have thought possible at the time - its shortwave station in Moosbrunn near Vienna is still active. In the meantime, however, we can speak of a remaining operation.

Of the antennas, only the quadrant antenna (the traditional omnidirectional antenna with a frequency of 6155 kHz), a rotatable logarithmic-periodic antenna for bridging medium distances and the large rotating antenna are still usable.

In 2022, the use of the broadcasting technology installed in the 1980s will end, as its operating costs are no longer competitive due to a significant increase in electricity prices. This meant that the company no longer had to work as a subcontractor for Media Broadcast and Encompass.

Two transmitters of this type with a nominal power of 100 kW each are active, either on one of the three antennas mentioned.

They were installed in 2000. At the time, the investment could be pushed through with the standard justification "digitalization", even though the demise of Radio Austria International was already becoming apparent.

The obligation to provide a foreign service from Austria only expires when the station is closed. That is why the frequency 6155 kHz is switched on with Austria 1 to this day. Since 2023, however, the broadcasting time has been limited to an absolute minimum: from Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:33 a.m.

Instead, productions from the German amateur radio association DARC are broadcast on Sundays; this from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. on 6070 kHz.

There will be another series of broadcasts for Europe until 2025: Radio Joystick, usually on the first Sunday of the month from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. on 7330 kHz.

The Sines broadcasting station, which was decommissioned in 2011 and has since been demolished, is in the state of an extensive modernization that was only carried out after 2000

The economic basis of operations in Moosbrunn today are the orders of a customer for whom the ORF technology subsidiary ORS also handles program distribution via Astra 19.2° East: the Free Church of the Seventh-day Adventists - Adventist World Radio.

From 1971 onwards, their first shortwave technology partner was Deutsche Welle with its stations in Portugal, which were also open to external users - again for legal reasons through subsidiaries.

From 1975 onwards, the broadcasters in Malta were also included, but this did not work due to technical inadequacies. When the government of Malta announced a three-month broadcasting ban in 1982, Adventist World Radio withdrew here.

In 1979, a collaboration with Radio Andorra began. These broadcasts inevitably ended in 1981 when the tiny state in the Pyrenees no longer allowed the transmitters to continue operating.

That's why Adventist World Radio moved to Italy and set up its own small station in Forlì, southwest of Ravenna, in 1985. He can be seen in this chronicle, which also shows many other things, including the recording room at the Sines station.

This was actually supposed to be the forerunner of a powerful shortwave station in Arganda, between Ferrara and Ravenna. The "groundbreaking ceremony" also took place there. Some transmitters and various antenna accessories were taken over from the Schwarzenburg station in Switzerland, which was closed in 1998.

A little later, however, Adventist World Radio dropped the project and also shut down the small station in Forlì in 2001. One of the transmitters from Schwarzenburg was sold to the station WMLK in the USA, where it fell victim to a fire in 2017.

A reminiscence of these times remains to this day: Every Sunday from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. there is a broadcast in Italian from Nauen on 9610 kHz. It is the last that Adventist World Radio still broadcasts on shortwave in Europe, since productions in Bulgarian were stopped in 2021.

The broadcasts from Portugal, in turn, came to an end when the Russian side made a cheaper offer. So from 1992 to 1996 the programs ran instead on the stations in the Moscow area, in Samara and in Yekaterinburg.

The next stop was Slovakia. Larger amounts of capacity became available there when Radio Prague ended the continued use of the stations on Slovak territory, which was initially practiced after the dissolution of the federal state.

Finally, in 2001, with the first step in winding down Radio Austria International, the Moosbrunn station was also looking for new tasks. This began Adventist World Radio's longest partnership to date with a broadcasting network operator in Europe, later supplemented by bookings with Media Broadcast.

The German language broadcasts were removed from Adventist World Radio's shortwave program in 2007.

In 2018, the satellite channel was also switched off and with it the withdrawal from linear radio in German-speaking countries. It was replaced by the Hope podcasts, as a supplement to the television program launched in 2009.

The Free Church media house in Darmstadt (today Alsbach-Hähnlein) began radio productions in German in 1948. In 1973, this section of the Protestant Church remarked on the contributions that were also included in the ARD church radio that they were "more purely biblical-evangelistic than Adventist-special church."

The shortwave broadcasts are also coordinated in Alsbach-Hähnlein.

Hi Wolfie, on page #563 there is a Multilingual entry for IBRA on 5130 kHz 1500-1800 UT. Multilingual because also other languages than Pashto has been reported by Tony Rogers at least:

The transmitter on 5130 kHz was switched on at 1446 UT today with tones until the start of songs at 1456 UT, which continued until 1533 UT (no announcements during this time); at 1533 UT a new programme started which appeared to be in Kazakh (despite me saying that I hadn't previously heard anything in a Central Asian language on a Monday!).

I tried translating some of the audio with Google Translate to see if I could identify the language for sure and using Kazakh as the source it did manage to translate a few words into "I'm the only one who has been in contact with each other in his life and knows what he sees and knows", so maybe that was part of a Christian message in Kazakh. Otherwise only odd words here and there so not exactly a successful exercise.

Stopped listening at 1555 UT so not sure if 'Radio Sadaye Zindagi' programmes in Dari followed.

With today, 1 May, being the first weekday of the month, the Kyrgyz transmitter on 5130 kHz should hopefully be back on air from around 1455 UT through to close at 1755v UT.

And with it being a Monday and based on previous monitoring it should be in Dari until 1530 UT with Christian talks (or perhaps mostly music), followed by South Asian-style songs (at least that's what they sound like to me) between 1530-1600 UT, which may include canned ID's in English such as "You've chosen the right station, it's Hit Short Wave" etc, and at 1600 UT back into Dari with Christian programmes for Afghanistan from 'Radio Sadaye Zindagi' (Afghan Voice) through to sign-off.

It has also been heard in a Central Asian language on some days, possibly Kazakh, but I've not noticed that on a Monday so far.

The 15 kW transmitter is unlikely to make it to the UK at this time of year but it might be heard with decent reception using the online Kiwi-SDR's in Novosibirsk and Novokuzneck, both in Russia, and weaker on the KiwiSDR in New Delhi, India {or Perseus SDR in Doha Qatar ME target, wb.}.

I don't think there is really any fixed schedule.

Most of the resistors, screws were not making contact due to rust and corrosion. The items were disconnected and cleaned. The final inductors are messed up and are not turning and will be taken out and cleaned shortly. There was one IC shorted in the controller and was replaced. One door interlock was damaged and had to be adjusted with a new part.

The previous engineer had a bad final tuning motor go out and replaced it with a stick to turn it. My son and I took a motor from a Harris transmitter (in storage) and got rid of the tuning stick. The Harris schematic diagram showed a switch for tuning and operation. There was a pot there and was replaced with a switch to match the diagram. The contact shoes for frequency change were in bad shape and were cleaned with sandpaper.

The pump in the water tank was not working and had to be replaced with a spare pump. This is only a sampling of the problems encountered. With the remaining problems, it will probably be about 2 months before the transmitter will be in operation on 12.105 kHz. George McClintock 26-May-2024".

This section includes a list of abbreviations and special terms used in this publication, a list of media - foreign agents and blocked by ROSKOMNADZOR (Federal Service for Supervision in the Sphere of Telecom, Information Technologies and Mass Media), as well as a list of changes in the Russian-language broadcasting that have occurred since the publication of the previous issue.

2. AIR BROADCASTING. Station listings in this section include frequency and programme schedules, transmitter location and power, target areas, postal addresses, phone/fax numbers, Web sites, social network pages, e-mail addresses as well as QSL policies of the stations (totally 51 stations from 33 countries and territories of the world).

3. The INTERNET BROADCASTING section contains the same information as in the previous one, but for Internet radio stations of state broadcasting, as well as stations that were earlier broadcast on the air in AM bands, and currently are on the Internet (totally 22 stations from 19 countries and territories of the world).

4. HISTORY OF BROADCASTING. In this historical section the article of Trans World Radio's history is continued.

BBC World Service reveals 310 of its journalists are working in exile

Recent crackdowns on press freedom in Russia, Afghanistan and Ethiopia have pushed more BBC teams to relocate for their own safety, many leaving family and friends behind.

This new figure was announced at World Service Presents, a three-day series of events highlighting the courageous work of journalists around the world, and the state of media freedom globally.

Journalists are facing increasing pressure, including state interference, harassment, and criminal charges, which are consistently used to attempt to undermine their work. Staff at BBC News Persian have been working in exile for over a decade and continue to face harassment and persecution. Last month, the BBC World Service filed an urgent appeal to the UN over abuse of national security and counter-terrorism laws against BBC News Persian journalists.

Following the invasion of Ukraine, BBC News Russian journalists and their families were moved out of Moscow to the Latvian capital of Riga. Now, 39 BBC staff remain in Riga, continuing the work of reporting independent and impartial news to audiences around the world in Russian. They also play an active part in countering disinformation about the war.

On 12 April, BBC Russian correspondent Ilya Barabanov was labelled as a "foreign agent" by the Russian justice ministry. Barabanov has written extensively about Russia's war in Ukraine. The "foreign agent" label has been used by the government to marginalise journalists and critics of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Ilya and the BBC reject the decision, which they are disputing in court.

Ilya Barabanov, says: "The most difficult part about exile is the lack of direct contact with people. We lost the opportunity to talk to our contributors. The inability to travel around Russia, report from the field, talk to real people – that's the hardest part about being a journalist in exile.

"In early April, the Russian authorities designated me a "foreign agent". This affected my status and ability to talk to people. I now must warn my contributors about this new, unpleasant status."

Liliane Landor, Director, BBC World Service says: "Press freedom is under increasingly intense pressure at a time when millions, voting in elections around the world, need to be well-informed of the choices ahead of them. The BBC's news services are blocked or difficult to access in many countries including China, Russia and Afghanistan.

"Our journalists face ongoing harassment and persecution from countries such as Iran and Russia to name but two. World Press Freedom Day is a stark reminder of the gravity of the situation underscoring the urgent need for journalists everywhere to be able to do their job unhindered."
