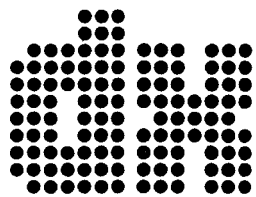


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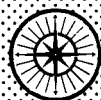
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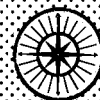

NEWS ABOUT BROADCASTING (+other) STATIONS

AWR Wavescan now produced by Jeff White and Ray Robinson with new name "WAVESCAN"

Adventist World Radio (AWR) has ended the use of all shortwave relay sites on October 26th, 2024. It is now using only its own shortwave station KSDA in Guam.

Jeff White and Ray Robinson were provided with the new schedule for KSDA about 10 days or so ago, and the immediately obvious thing was that there were no English language programs on the schedule at all, including no Wavescan. We have sought clarification from a number of people at AWR, but have not received any response. No one at AWR has informed us that Wavescan has been canceled, but it seems that is their intention, at least in so far as their own platforms are concerned. Jose Jacob in India has confirmed that Wavescan was not broadcast via KSDA on Sunday, and furthermore this week's edition has not been posted on AWR's podcast page (<https://awr.org/program/engmi_wav>).

However, the show will very much continue in production with Jeff and Ray, just as before, but we guess now just as 'Wavescan' and not 'AWR Wavescan' any longer. To be clear, neither Jeff nor Ray have any association with AWR, or with the Seventh Day Adventist Church. Dr. Adrian Peterson, Wavescan's Founder and Editor-in-Chief did of course, but he is now in his mid-90's, and he retired from any active involvement with the show some 18 months ago.

So, we are now in active negotiations to get the show carried by one or two other shortwave stations with coverage into Asia. It will continue on WRMI, WWCR, VOH-Africa and IRRS. And, there is now a new podcast platform for the show, at: <<https://wavescan.podomatic.com>>.

This has the shows from the past couple of months, including the edition that aired yesterday on some stations.

ARMENIA: Yerevan Gavar-ARM MW site outlet 1395 kHz

Unless reception is poor on KiwiSDR's in Russia and the Middle East, I am not hearing Public Radio of Armenia on 1395 kHz from Gavar (Armenia) between 1600-1745 UT. IRIB Iran is dominant instead. Has PRA discontinued their MW broadcasts or is my monitoring just not picking them out?

In the past there was a gap of 15 minutes on 1395 kHz between the end of the PRA broadcast at 1745 UT until the start of the NHK relay in Persian at 1800 UT, but surprisingly on both 8 and 9 October 2024 I noticed Radio Erena, the target broadcast to Eritrea, suddenly appear out of nowhere with strong reception from 1747 UT on the 8th and from 1757 UT on the 9th.

It seems that the feed for Radio Erena (which is on shortwave 9585 kHz via Yerevan Gavar center between 1700-1800 UT) is kicking in on 1395 kHz as well. The Radio Erena broadcast ends at 1759 UT with a few seconds of the Encompass signature tune, before NHK starts as expected at 1800 UT, followed by filler music at 1820-1830 UT and AWR 360

in Arabic at 1830-2030 UT.

I presume Encompass is the broker for both Radio Erena and the block between 1800-2030 UT on 1395 kHz, with their signature tune also being heard briefly at the end of the AWR 360 broadcast at 2029 UT.

AUSTRIA: ORS shortwave station Moosbrunn will close down on December 31, 2024, after having lost its biggest customer Adventist World Radio (AWR) at the end of October.

Other than religious stn blaring on 4840 kHz; WRMI on 5010 kHz; and Rebelde 5025 kHz, not much else across entire 60 mb!

CUBA: Cuba radio OFF AIR

Due to the effects of the hurricanes, Cuba is suffering a lack of electricity - once again - and got a blackout last night. Most of the Medium Wave stations are silent, including the usual SW 5025 kHz Radio Rebelde which was off last night and this morning.

It is probable that because lack of energy we just hear sporadic broadcasting services from now onwards. (Jorge Garzon-Cantabria-ESP EA1FOV; BrDXC-UK iogr Nov 7)

Radio Rebelde was still off air on 5025 kHz when I checked this morning (8 Nov) at 0430 UT. But (listening on the Kiwi SDR in Bermuda) I could hear Rebelde on MW 1180 and 1620 kHz (with continuous Rod Stewart songs, a programme I've heard before on Rebelde). Stronger on 1620 kHz was Radio Bayamo, which is in the south east of the island, away from the provinces further west damaged by Hurricane Rafael.

UNE (Union Electrica de Cuba) reported some power stations on the island back on line or starting-up last night. But the power infrastructure close to the path of the hurricane has suffered much damage (their Twitter/X page has photos

of collapsed twisted pylons).

But power black outs were increasing in frequency and duration before this hurricane hit the island because of fuel shortages for the power stations - the total closure of the main power station on October 17th was because a ship with fuel oil was delayed because of previous hurricane Oscar. The ultimate cause of the fuel (and other) shortages on the island is of course the 60+ year economic, commercial and financial blockade imposed by the USA against Cuba.

Once again at the end of October, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution calling for the end of the USA's embargo on Cuba by 187 votes to 2 (with 1 abstention).

Trans World Radio is running a fundraising campaign for its Manzini facility:

"This broadcast station is at risk for experiencing frequent rolling power outages, some up to eight hours, due to inadequate supply. Our backup generators, one over 40 years old, are failing and replacement parts don't exist. We need new generators as quickly as possible to keep the gospel on the airwaves!"

Apparently, the projected cost is \$408,000.

ETHIOPIA: 6030 kHz **Radio Oromiya** via Gedja site, 0320+ UT, Oct 26 via remote KiwiSDR in Nairobi, Kenya; mostly announcers in vernacular and some African music; poor reception, but was grey line reception (Nairobi sunrise at 0312 UT and Addis Ababa sunrise at 0313 UT). Reception in the States nearly impossible due to Radio Marti on frequency. (Ron Howard-Monterey-CA-USA, via wwdxc BC-DX TopNews Oct 26)

Voice of Fano, which broadcasts in Amharic to Ethiopia on 15215 kHz at 1700-1815 on Wednesdays and Saturdays, now appears as a HFCC registration. It confirms that the broadcast is brokered by Radio Miami International (RMI) and is coming from TDF Issoudun in France with 500 kW. However, the latest registration states that the start date for this entry is 220924 (24 September 2024), although it has seemingly been on air since 1 May 2024. The registration also indicates that the days of the broadcasts will be Mondays and Thursdays, rather than the current Wednesdays and Saturdays. There is no entry showing for this in the RMI schedule for A24. One to keep an eye on from 24 September.

If anyone can confirm the days of operation for Voice of Fano, please let me know. Thanks.

FINLAND: Arctic Radio 252 in Inari, northern Finland, is planning broadcasts on long wave 252 kHz. Originally, the first test broadcast was announced on the website for 1 October 2024 and then broadcasts at weekends, but this was no longer the case in September. Now there was more general talk of tests in October and regular weekend broadcasts from 1 November. Special broadcasts for Christmas (25-27 December 2024) and New Year's Eve (31 December 2024) were still announced.

Programmes in English, Finnish and three forms of Sami have been announced. The 252 kHz frequency was chosen because it was allocated to Finland in the 1975 wave plan. The national public broadcaster YLE gave up this long wave as early as 1993. After Raidió Teilifís Éireann ceases broadcasting in 2023 (and the transmitter is demolished), the frequency will only be used by Algerian radio. However, the Tipaza facility is often out of service and co-channel interference should not be an issue during the day in the local area. Arctic Radio is to start with 1 kW and increase the transmission power if the project proves successful.

Radio Blacksmith Knoll (6120 kHz) has a new licence that runs until 4 January 2025. This was announced by operator Marco Johansson on 5 October 2024. The licence allows broadcasts from Saturday 00:01 to Sunday 23:59, but Johansson's equipment would not be able to withstand continuous operation. Until an official restart, the station will work on the technology and programme; among other things, Marco Johansson also wants to integrate music that is not in the public

KUWAIT: Radio Kuwait - MW 1134 kHz service is listed as "Main Arabic Programme & Sports Matches" by the Ministry of Information on their website at <<https://media.gov.kw/Frequency.aspx?FreqType=RadioMW>> but I have noticed recently, regardless of the opt-outs for football commentaries, it is not//to the Main Arabic Programme on 540 kHz and seems to be a completely different service.

Content that I have heard includes sports discussions, Arabic music, Islamic programmes, plays, so a bit of a mixed bag, but definitely not // to 540 kHz as it used to be.

I have been trying to translate various announcements from Arabic to English using Google and two things that stand out are the ID "Kuwait State Radio" and the frequency of "96.3 FM". Checking in WRTH 2024 and online, that FM frequency is used by Radio Kuwait International Channel, so is that what is now going out on 1134 kHz?

I'm not sure what the background is or if this is a permanent change, but one to keep an eye on. Both 540 and 1134 kHz from Kuwait are frequently heard in the British Isles at night.

KYRGYZ REPUBLIC: 5130 kHz at 1700 UT Sedaye Zindagi via Krasnaya-Rechka near Bishkek Kyrgyzstan site - talks in VV {? WB - rather Dari/Pashto ? }, fair signal but very difficult to hear as low modulation. "Sedaye Zindagi" ID at 1750 UT, choir, tx off 1756 UT. Logged on Oct 14 & 15. Not heard Oct+ 16. 232 Oct 14

The relay of Sedaye Zindagi via Krasnaya-Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan on 5130 kHz is not often reported here, but was heard on the recent SheigraDXpedition. It is difficult to hear because of its low modulation and low power (reportedly 15 kW). It also has an unusual schedule as it only broadcasts in the first half of the month (i.e. 1st to 15th) on weekdays only at 1455v- 1755v UTC according to the Asia on Shortwave guide produced by Tony Rogers <<http://bdxc.org.uk/asia.pdf>> (BrDXC-UK iogr 'Communication' magazine Nov 2024, also via wor Nov 5)

MADAGASCAR: 11610 kHz RFeda {via MWV New Life Station, Mahajanga, Madagascar; at 2220 UT. Some very unusual music with accordions, man and woman at the BoH with dialogue in Arabic. Nice ME music with male vocal

at 2255 UT, closing announcement by man, ID and off at 2259 UT. VG at a time with otherwise dismal band condx. Good on Oct 11. (Rick Barton, Sun City-AZ-USA, wor Oct 14)

MALAYSIA: Miri FM on 11665 kHz, broadcasting in Kenyah language.

On Oct 23, checking from tune-in at 0932 till 1000 UT, on 11665 kHz, via the remote SDR at Talsay City, the Philippines; heard MiriFM in scheduled Kenyah language (a group of languages spoken in Sarawak, Malaysia, and Kalimantan, Indonesia, that share a common ancestor, Proto-Kenyah); after years of listening to WaiFM, today was certainly unique; DJ playing pop songs; decent reception, but some adjacent QRM. At 1000 UT, switched to Wai FM programs in scheduled Iban language, and suddenly with frequent Wai_FM IDs.

REE's confusing B24 sked at HFCC <<http://www.hfcc.org/data/schedbybrc.php?seas=B24&broadc=REE>> pretends everything is in Spanish! The possible frequencies M/W/F at 2300- 2300 UT when English is expected: ME 12030 kHz. AF 17755 or 21620 Khz. SoAM 17715 or 11940 kHz. NoAM 17855 or 9690 kHz. Likely the lower ones really in use, the higher as alt/backup ?

{Previous winter seasons REE used 9690, 12030, 17715 and 17755 kHz, WB}

PLUS a separate broadcast, the only one at 302 degrees azimuth, further west toward NorthAmerica than 290 deg azi for the rest, this one on 15110 kHz at 2000-2400 UT daily.

But that would require 5 transmitters at once: anticipating the first new one? Power for each as 200 kW. Hours and frequencies are quite different weekends.

UNITED KINGDOM: Longwave 198 kHz. The electricity industry has agreed to fast-track installation of up to 800,000 smart meters to replace radio-tele switches (RTS) which rely on the longwave signal to switch between peak and off-peak rates. Many of the radio tele switches are in Scotland and BBC Radio Scotland carried reports about this on 3rd October making clear that there is a June 2025 deadline for replacing all of the old RTS devices. So the June 2025 could be when the BBC plans to close its three longwave transmitters, although this has yet to be confirmed by the BBC. U.S.A.: WMLK 9275 kHz in DRM mode: I confirm reception in Ottawa of WMLK in DRM mode on 9275 kHz at 2330UT on 31 Oct. According to Dream software: SNR between 13 and 18dB, DRM mode B 10kHz,xHE-AAC Stereo 17.46kbps. Text message: "WMLK Radio DRM transmission with Ampegon TSW2300 transmitter - stay tuned -at- 9275 kHz"

Audio Bandwidth was about 15 kHz, but the program audio was not very good quality, lacking in bass. The program content was a preacher and later a choir singing a few hymns. I recorded while decoding the Shortwave Radiogram on 9265 kHz. I captured only about 16 minutes of audio, with some extended periods free of dropouts. At some point, the signal switched back to AM. (JColes0727, wor Nov 1)

Anker Petersen - RIP

One of the founders of the European DX Council and known all over the world, Danish DXer Anker Petersen died recently at the age of 83. Anker was absolutely “a big person” in the DX world. He started the hobby in mid-1950s together with his school-mate Kaj Bredahl Jörgensen. They became life-long friends.

To those who knew Anker his occupation was a bit surprising – he was a soldier. He served in the Danish Air Force and also in NATO activities and retired as colonel. Since the mid-1960s he had a house in Skovlunde near Copenhagen and lived there for the rest of his life. He was single.

Anker was always a shortwave man. He listened and even reported local AM stations during his many trips, but at home he spent his time with the shortwave specialising in the tropical bands. We can probably say that both the rise and the fall of the shortwaves was timed parallel to his lifeline. His best-known product was the annual Tropical Bands Survey, a very good tool for all listeners of those bands. As the number of tropical bands stations went down drastically, he added all domestic shortwave stations to the list and renamed it as the Domestic Broadcasting Survey.

Anker, Kaj and their team turned the club into the most international DX club in the world. The Danish Short Wave Club International and their magazine Shortwave News operated in English and had members in many countries. The slogan “The club that was global long before globalisation” describes this well. DSWCI was a great club, but like pretty much all clubs it had a problem finding new guys to help run it. The club eventually ceased at the end of 2016. The closing ceremonies in November 2016 at the Kalundborg longwave station was a big happening with attendees from all over the world. The website dswci.org will exist up to the 5th of March 2025, so hurry up and utilise the information available.

Some 55 years ago The DX Window of Radio Denmark was the number one DX programme on shortwave and Anker was of course a member of the team. The World Radio TV Handbook was at that time a Danish publication and he was one of those who worked on its contents. He always contributed very accurate information. The long-time editor-in-chief of the WRTH Jens Frost and Anker were close friends.

The European DX Council was founded in 1967 at Anker’s house in Skovlunde. The meeting of 1968 was held there, too. Anker was involved in many activities of the EDXC and he attended most of the conferences. I think the last time we met was in the Tampere conference 2017. He had to give up travelling because of health issues, but he continued his DX hobby.

Thank you Anker for the longtime friendship and especially for your important services to the DX community.

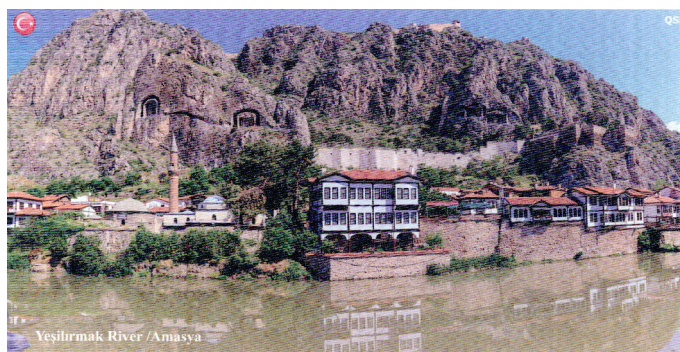
