ARMENIA/TURKEY: Many SWLs may have been surprised today. Between 11500 and 11550 kHz, there is radio silence. Neither Denge Gel nor a Turkish jamming station could be heard.

The solution to this mystery is simple: Radio Dengê Gel has ended its 23-year broadcasting history. This was reported by the Kurdish news agency Ajansa Nûçeyan a Firatê (ANF) on its website
<https://english.anf-news.com/news/the-voice-of-the-revolution-radyoya-denge-gel-has-ended-its-broadcasts-82451>

The station began in 2001 as "Dengê Mezopotamya" (until 2012), then broadcast under the name "Dengê Kurdistanê" until 2017, and finally as "Dengê Welat". In 2023, it finally became "Dengê Gel" ("Voice of the People").

The station, which played a cat-and-mouse game with the Turkish authorities on shortwave (since 2019, Turkey has been using jammers against "Dengê Welat/Gel"), aimed its programmes on politics, literature, history and songs primarily at its Kurdish listeners. Later, a programme in Turkish, "Medya Haber" ("Media News"), was added. The programmes were produced in Denderleeuw near Brussels.

Now the station has ended its 23-year, eventful history on shortwave – closing with the Kurdish national anthem "Ey Reqîp", as reported by ANF.

ISRAEL: Closure of 'Galei Zahal' radio station.

A few weeks ago, we reported on 'Galei Zahal', the Israeli military radio station. We described it as a media anomaly, an almost unique case: a military radio station that is open to the exchange of opinions, including critical voices against various governments, which often threatened to shut it down.

Now this threat seems to be becoming a reality.

The defense minister of Netanyahu's government has officially announced a proposal to end 'Galei Zahal's broadcasts.

Israeli Defense Minister Katz announced last Wednesday that he will soon submit a proposal to the government to close the Israeli Armed Forces radio station 'Galei Zahal', with the shutdown scheduled for March 1, 2026. Based on the recommendations of a commission that investigated the activities of 'Galei Zahal', the team will work to preserve Gal Galatz, a station that mainly broadcasts music and traffic reports.

Operating a civilian radio station under military control is an anomaly that does not exist in any other democratic country.

Katz added that since the 1950s, various defense ministers and IDF chiefs of staff have considered closing the station, removing it from the military framework, privatizing it, or closing its news department. However, none of these processes has been completed.

KIRIBATI: No news as yet as to when Radio Kiribati will reactivate 1440 AM after the antenna tower was accidentally damaged in mid-September. However I have found an intriguing reference to a reference to another AM frequency in the final paragraph of the following 'About Us' section on the BPA website. I suspect the reference to 1449 is actually a typo which should be 1440 ! Radio Kiribati is a public radio station owned and managed by the Broadcasting & Publications Authority (BPA), a Kiribati Government entity. It began operations in October 1954. While the government provides funding for infrastructure, it is run as a commercial station and most of its revenue comes from advertising. It also charges government bodies that wish to have programmes broadcast by the station.

Radio Kiribati's programmes cater to the general population of Kiribati; its programming is 75 percent in the local language (I-Gilbertese) and 25 percent in English, all of which is locally produced. The station also relays live sittings of the House of Parliament which are held 4 times a year. Radio Kiribati transmits via a 10 kW AM transmitter located on the Tarawa atoll and operates an FM station (250 Watt) on Kiritimati Island.

BPA also relays the ABC Radio through an AM 1449 kHz & FM station FM 89.9 MHz on Tarawa. Radio Kiribati reaches almost all residents of Kiribati.

PHILIPPINES: Radyo Pilipinas to return to shortwave on 1 December 2025. On 20 Nov 2025, John Zachary Alvarez posted the following message from Radyo Pilipinas to the Short-Wave Fan Facebook group (translated from Filipino to English):

"Back on Air! Radyo Pilipinas World Service on Shortwave, Will Again Delivered News to the Global Filipinos". The U.S. Agency for Global Media USAGM has formally announced the revival of PBS-BBS Radyo Pilipinas World Service's shortwave broadcast operations. It is widely considered one of the most important voices on the air. Starting December 1, 2025, broadcasting will resume using the facilities of the Philippines Transmitting Station in Tinang, Tarlac. The announcement, made through an Information Memorandum from USAGM Philippines Station Manager Charles Shepard, marks a positive change and strengthening of international broadcasting partnerships.

This decision ensures that Radyo Pilipinas World Service will once again be able to reach a vast global Filipino audience, including our Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) and communities in remote areas through the reliable shortwave radio band. This important return comes after a period in which many partnerships and agreements, such as the one involving Voice of America (VOA), were severed or reduced, particularly during the early days of President Donald Trump's administration.

According to PBS-BBS Director General Fernando "Dindo" Amparo Sanga, "the re-establishment of this crucial platform is seen as a commitment to maintaining a vital information link for Filipinos across the globe". USAGM Headquarters in Washington, D.C. confirmed their approval for the resumption of broadcast operations. The Memorandum, addressed to PBS BBS World Service Station Manager Remigio Sampang, also expressed their gratitude for their continued dedication and support of the mission. SPAIN: Spain to switch off mediumwave in December - FM and DAB+ to take over

Radio Nacional España (RNE), Spain's public broadcaster, has announced that it will switch off its mediumwave transmitters at the end of 2025.

According to an RNE statement, the majority of radio listeners in Spain have been listening to mediumwave less and less since the 1980s, following the establishment of nationwide FM coverage. Since then, the audience for medium wave has declined steadily, with RNE now reaching only 1% of the Spanish population. At the same time, fewer and fewer new radios still offer mediumwave reception, and the same applies to radio receivers in many new cars.

According to current plans, RNE's mediumwave transmissions will end before 31 December this year. RNE intends to inform its listeners about this through a campaign presenting the various alternative reception options, including terrestrial digital radio and web radio. At the same time, the aim is to improve the coverage of FM and DAB+ transmitter networks in those regions where medium wave has previously offered more reliable reception.

Fans of long-distance radio reception still have a few weeks left to try to receive RNE's various regional stations on medium wave. Frequencies, transmitter locations and times of regional programmes can be found in the current WRTH or at <<http://www.mwlist.org>>.

Local station managers have been instructed to refer any listener complaints to the "Defensora de la Audiencia" (Ombudsman). 


