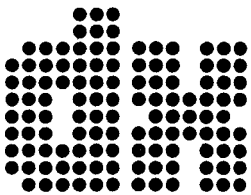

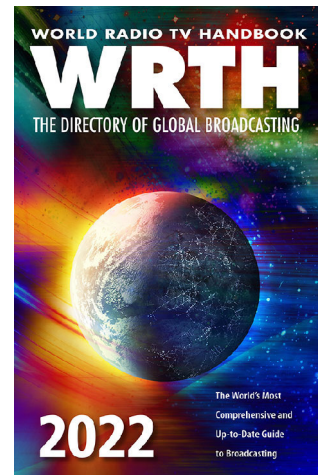
It is with deep sadness that we announce that our old friend **Wolf Harranth**, OE1WHC, founder of the DokuFunk Archive, passed away on Tuesday, August 3rd, 2021 in Klosterneuburg after a short and serious illness.

Wolf Harranth was an Austrian children's book author, translator and journalist who also worked as a radio actor as a child. The most famous role he played on Austrian radio was that of "Wolferl" in "Our Radio Family". Then he began to work at the Jungbrunnen publishing house, where he not only became a lecturer, but ultimately also managing director. In addition, he was active in the ORF from the 1970's and for the broadcaster Radio Austria International (ROI).

Wolf has played a decisive role in the founding of the German DX head organisation AGDX (Arbeitsgemeinschaft DX) in 1973. He has also created and in the beginning also published their monthly magazine "weltweit hören".

Wolf was also a very active radio amateur who achieved great successes in this area, which demanded a lot from him, but also gave him great joys. With this hobby he got far more around the world and among the people than anyone could ever be able to do in the traditional way. From all these fields of activity, Wolf gathered friends who now mourn him as a person.

Perhaps CRI is waiting to see how many listeners will write in and complain that the regular programmes in German are missing. If they get a lot of responses, they could reinstate the programmes on short wave.

Sept 27 had very strong CNR1 jamming occurring on 7210 kHz, from 0828+ UT, blocking Sound of Hope (Taiwan). Recently CNR1 has been fairly active; in the past it was rarely heard here

6035 kHz, is "Yunnan Radio International" service in Vietnamese and Chinese; since Jan 10 of this year, I have heard this new service blocking any chance I might have had to hear BBS (Bhutan) on this frequency. Since Jan, Yunnan is no longer relaying FM99 here. On Sept 27, heard the International Service's musical IS at 0955 UT, before they started their programming in Vietnamese and later changing over to Chinese.

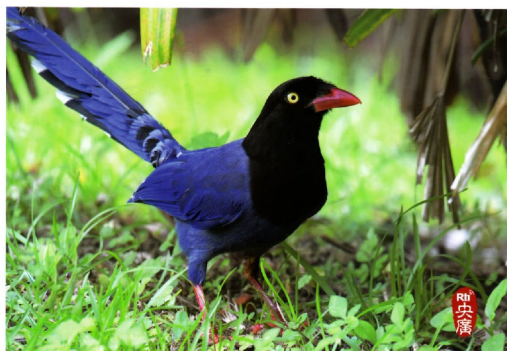

Nachruf Wolf Harranth

Leider haben wir die schlimme Nachricht erhalten, dass Wolf Harranth in der Nacht vom 3. auf den 4. August in Wien verstorben ist. Am 19. August hätte er seinen 80. Geburtstag gefeiert.

Die AGDX e.V. hat OM Harranth sehr viel zu verdanken. Ohne seinem großen Einsatz und Überzeugungsarbeit in vielen nächtlichen Sitzungen, wäre es wohl nie zu einer Gründung des Dachverbandes AGDX e.V. im Jahre 1973 gekommen. Auch war er der Begründer und Namensgeber der Klubzeitschrift "weltweit hören – kurz: wwh", die in den Jahren 1973 bis 1998 monatlich erschienen ist.



Wie kam es dazu.... Ein kurzer Rückblick:

Im Jahre 1968 gründeten Jugendliche in Jugenheim an der Bergstraße (zwischen Darmstadt und Mannheim) den Kurzwellenhörer-Verein *Assoziation junger DXer an der Bergstraße*, abgekürzt *adxb*. Mit wachsender Mitgliederzahl wurde der Vereinsname in *Assoziation junger DXer (adxb)* geändert, so dass heute nur noch das "b" im Namenskürzel auf die Herkunft des Vereins hinweist. Der Verein gewann schnell eine beachtliche Mitgliederzahl im deutschsprachigen Raum, vor allem in Deutschland und in Österreich. OM Harranth wurde darauf aufmerksam, dass es noch andere Kurzwellenhörer gibt, die sich sogar in einem Verein organisiert haben. Er übernahm die Initiative für den österreichischen Raum und dies führte dazu, dass sich der Verein im Jahre 1970 in die deutsche *adxb-DL* und die österreichische *adxb-OE* (nun *ADXB-OE*) aufteilte. Diese Aufteilung wird auch noch heute stringent gelebt, so können Hobbyfreunde aus Österreich nur im "Austrian DX Board" (ehemals *adxb-OE*) Mitglied werden. Eine Absprache, die nun seit mehr als 50 Jahren vollzogen wird.

Schnell wuchs die Idee, die zahlreichen Vereine unter einem Dachverband zu vereinen. Auch wenn es in der Anfangszeit schwierig war, die verschiedensten Interessen unter einen Hut zu bringen, Wolf Harranth war die treibende Kraft zur Gründung der AGDX e.V.

Gerne erinnert sich der Schreiber dieser Zeilen an eine Delegiertenversammlung in Wien, dessen Rahmenprogramm von Wolf Harranth gestaltet wurde. In Rekordzeit zeigte er uns einige Schönheiten der Stadt Wien und führte uns durch ein Museum mit den Worten: "Wenn Euch einer fragt, ihr seid vom deutschen Fernsehen.....". Vielleicht erinnert sich der eine oder andere Teilnehmer von damals an seine Worte.

Auch wenn Wolf nicht mehr unter uns weilt, sein Geist lebt in der AGDX e.V. weiter.
