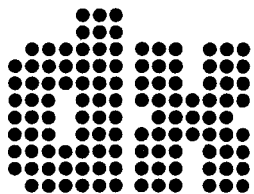

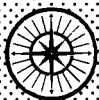

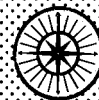

BHUTAN - 6035.01, 0038-0054, Bhutan BS, Thimphu, 21/03, Dzongkha, OM talks, typical local singing without/with local music - fair with splashes from 6030 (ROU), then poor due to downward propagation. (Mikhail Timofeyev, North-East part of the St. Petersburg city, Russia, lcom R75, 15 meters outdoor long wire, HCDX via WOR 1505, DXLD)

6035, 24/3 0001 BBS, Bhutan, talks by man followed by monks' slow music, fair/good. It sound like they are on air with 100 kW again (Giampiero Bernardini, RX: Perseus, ANT: Wellbrook LFL 1010, QTH: Bocca di Magra, Italia, dxldyg via WOR 1505, DXLD)

The BBS transmitter was on repair in February 2010, and under test in first week of March, it was irregular then, but last 10 days its noted strong & continuous between 0100 UTC to 1500 UTC, I think they have recommissioned the 100kw Thompson TXR at full duty... The Signal is very strong like S9+30 db here without any ext. antenna (- I leave only approx. 350+ KM aerial distance from Thimpu, Bhutan) and can be listened very well without erecting any telescopic whip, inside living room, great audio with S9+.

Try 0500-0600 and 0800-0900 UT in English (Partha Sarathi Goswami, Rx. Sony 7600GR and Redsun RP2100, Siliguri, West Bengal, India) AND English at 14-15, no? That's only chance in WNA (gh, DXLD)

6035, BBS (tentative), March 24. Thanks to the timely tip from Giampiero Bernardini! Recently I have checked here from about 1330 to 1400 to only find PBS Yunnan in Chinese with no other station noted. Today at 1346 tune-in clearly heard two stations mixing together. BBS seemed to improve over assume Yunnan by 1350; played unique indigenous music/singing; announcer taking several on-air phone calls in assume Dzongkha (clearly not in Chinese); matches their schedule and as heard here in the past during this time period; played one pop song; after

1400 there was too much QRM from the adjacent splatter to decipher what was happening. Needs more monitoring now that they have increased their power! (Ron Howard, Asilomar Beach, CA, Etón E1, dxldyg via WOR 1505, DXLD)

In A-10 the situation will change, as the Dutch broadcasts via Bonaire move one UT hour earlier at 0400-0427 and 0500-0527, and Croatia also starts an hour earlier at 0500. Turkey in English is also on there until 0355 or so. WRTH says Chad starts at 0425, so the window should then be 0427-0459 when propagation should be better anyway; maybe still audible after 0527 but depending on Croatia QRM or maybe that fading out earlier in summer; not considering possible adjacent-channel problems. Of course Chad could revert to 4905 or 7120 at any time (gh, DXLD)

CUBA - I've yet to find 5040 on the Spanish website, and of course the transmission schedule has not been updated. A few days ago RHC said it would start operations on 5040 kHz March 22 at 2300. An announcement recorded by Jose Bueno gives the Spanish segment on 5040 as 02-11 UT.

On March 22 at 2330, 5040 was indeed on with very good signal amid English. Arnie Coro says it's a NVIS antenna with limited coverage, but like Rebelde on 5025, it really gets out horizontally as well as vertically.

This does replace 13790 also for English, no longer heard during the 23-24 hour. Kept monitoring 5040 and heard: 0000 French, 0100 Creole, 0130 French, 0200 Spanish. Supposed to run Spanish all the way until 1100 but at 0540 noticed it was off; not sure when it quit, but maybe around 0500 when other transmitter/frequency changes are made.

5040 seems a good clear frequency for RHC, but if you hear a het from 5039.18, that's poor Radio Libertad, Junín,

Perú, as measured recently by Bob Wilkner, FL at 1050-1110, and presumably trying to be heard in the evenings. RHC 5040 also squeezes out poor Pará 5045, especially with WWRB staying on 5050 all-night, and presumably RHC will too later as planned (gh, WOR 1505, DXLD)

Radio Havana Cuba with strong signal on 5040 kHz tonight (22 March) at 2345 UT tune-in as announced on their website with Caribbean Outlook programme in English. SIO 443 - stronger than Rebelde on 5025 here in UK. Switched to French programme at 0000 UTC.

Russia switched to daylight saving time on the night of Sunday, March 28, at 2:00 a.m. local time, when the clocks were moved forward one hour. At the same time in the five regions whose time zones have change their residents will not have to reset their clocks and watches. Russia has 11 time zones, from Kaliningrad, which lags behind Moscow by one hour to Kamchatka. The time zones which were moved one hour closer to Moscow's time consist

only of Udmurtia and the Samara region as well as the most eastern time zone, which includes Chukotka and Kamchatka. On the night of March 28, five regions, by order of the Russian government will change their time zones. The Kemerovo and the Samara regions, Udmurtia, Kamchatka and Chukotka, do not switch to daylight saving time. Udmurtia and the Samara Region were moved to Moscow time, and the time zone which contained only the two areas has ceased to exist. Gone also is the eastern Russian time zone: Chukotka and Kamchatka, which were nine hours ahead of Moscow, now have the same time as Magadan and are now eight hours ahead of Moscow. The Kemerovo region also moved an hour closer to Moscow time. It is the westernmost of the Western Siberian Regions whose time zone was moved, outrunning the capital by three hours. It is possible that in future, Russia will abandon the system "summer" and "winter" time, or daylight savings time as it is commonly known in the west. IBB should never have chosen 7365. In A-10 the 13-14 hour from HSK9 via Udorn in Japanese, Chinese and Thai moves to 9575.

- 6297.1 CLANDESTINE (Western Sahara), National Radio of Saharui Republic, 2140-2216 Mar 13, discussion program to 2152 when local vocals were heard. Music fanfare, ID at 2159 followed by man and woman with announcements. Time pips at 2200 followed by another ID and news by a man announcer. Fair. More music programming at 2209.
- 7385 CLANDESTINE (Sudan), Miraya FM via Rimavska Sobota, Slovakia, *0259-0343 Feb 28, opening with instrumental music, man announcer with ID and announcements in Arabic. Into news read by a man. Features, ads and frequent "Radio Thailand News" IDs as program continued. Fair to good signal with fluttery reception. Some deterioration by sign off.

12095 ASCENSION ISLANDS, BBC, 2223-2245 Mar 13, English transmission with program Body and Soul about mourner's prayers. ID at 2230 followed by One Planet program at 2232 featuring talk about conservation. Fair to good. (D'Angelo-PA)

RADIO FREE ASIA RELEASES FOURTH RADIO PIONEER QSL CARD

RFA announces the release of the fourth QSL card in its Radio Pioneer series. The card honors Russian physicist Alexander S. Popov. Popov demonstrated that a receiver could detect the electromagnetic waves produced by lightning discharges in the atmosphere many miles away. In 1895, Popov was able to receive and detect the radio waves produced by an oscillator circuit. In 1897 he successfully sent a ship-to-shore transmission over a distance of 3 miles and then persuaded Russian naval authorities to begin installing radio equipment in its vessels; just two years later he had increased the distance of ship-to-shore transmissions to 30 miles. Popov is credited being the first to use an antenna in the transmission and reception of radio waves. The QSL card below will be issued for all valid RFA reception reports from **April 1 – June 30, 2010**.

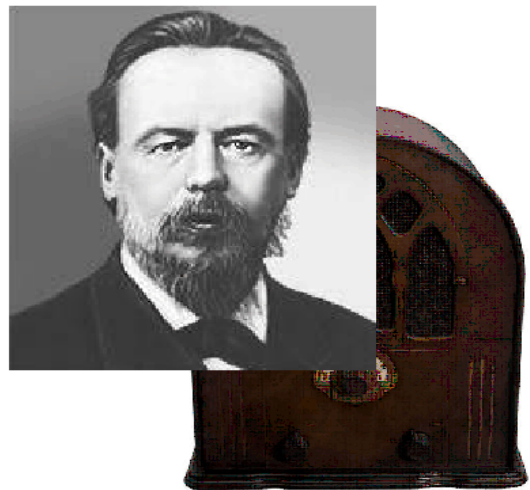
Created and funded by the U.S. Congress, Radio Free Asia (RFA) began in March 1996. As a surrogate broadcast network, RFA provides accurate and timely information, news and commentary about events in Asia. It is a forum for a variety of opinions and voices from within Asian nations whose people do not fully enjoy freedom of expression.

RFA broadcasts only in local languages and dialects - in Mandarin, Cantonese, Uyghur, and the Wu dialect; Tibetan (Uke, Amdo, and Kham); Burmese; Khmer to Cambodia; Korean to North Korea; Lao; and Vietnamese. Each language service is made up of native language speakers. This distinctive programming reflects each of these unique cultures.

RFA gives its Asian listeners a vehicle to voice their own thoughts through twelve call-in programs—one in Cantonese, one in Khmer, five in Mandarin, four in Tibetan and one in Uyghur. Daily broadcasts incorporate reports from correspondents and stringers throughout the world.

RFA has offices across Asia and is headquartered in Washington, DC.
