The 54 years old **DSWCI** which counts experienced DX-ers in 33 countries all over the world as members, has issued the 13th Edition of its annual **Domestic Broadcasting Survey**. This survey is divided into three parts: Part 1: The 39th edition of the Tropical Bands Survey covering all ACTIVE broadcasting stations on 2300 - 5700 kHz, including clandestines. Part 2: Domestic stations on international shortwave bands above 5700 kHz broadcasting to a domestic audience. Part 3: Deleted frequencies between 2 and 30 MHz which have not been reported heard during the past five years, but may reappear. (This Part 3 is only published in the E-mail version, but buyers of the printed version can get a copy from the Editor upon request)

All buyers of DBS-13 will get a username and password to the monthly updates on the tropical bands published as "Tropical Bands Monitor" on our website. The similar data from 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 are available at <<http://www.dswci.org/tbm>> to anybody. The 26 pages A-4 size DBS-13 is available by e-mail as pdf-format (about 955 kB). A limited number is also available printed on paper. It has 23 pages without Part 3.

Thomson Broadcast is supplying a 250 kW TSW 2300D shortwave transmitter, together with the rotatable HP-RCA 2/2/0.5 shortwave antenna system. The new transmitter and antenna installation will be located at the Kabirpur Shortwave

- 4775 SWAZILAND. Trans World Radio – Manzini, 0442-0455 Mar 11, noted with English program – man preaching followed by choir vocals. Poor to fair with some CODAR splatter.
- 4800 CHINA. Voice of China – Ge'ermu, 1121-1146 Feb 19, features by a man and woman in Chinese. Instrumental music and announcements at 1128 followed by ID and music fanfare at 1130. News and features followed. Poor to fair.
- 5910 COLOMBIA. Alcaravan Radio – Puerto Lleras, 0351-0432 Mar 3, nice program of Colombia music hosted by a man announcer with Spanish talk, time pips at 0400 under vocal selection, with frequent IDs and frequency announcements. Fair to good.
- 5915 ZAMBIA. Radio 1 – ZNBC, *0243-0300 Feb 17, familiar Fisheagle IS followed by orchestra National Anthem. Talk by a woman but very weak, hard to make out words. Poor mixing with unidentified co-channel station and eventually overtaken by Iran with light instrumental music and ID at 0259.
- 6105 USA. Family Radio – Okeechobee, 0934-0945 Feb 16, talk by man with woman periodically alternating; all in Portuguese. ID at 0943 followed by more talk. Poor to fair with QRM vocals in background which was more interesting but never faded up enough to ID.
- 6134.8 BOLIVIA. Radio Santa Cruz, 0923-0955 Feb 16, lively CP instrumental music hosted by man announcer with Spanish talk. Rustic vocals followed by ID and TC. Fair.
- 6165 ZAMBIA. Radio 2 – ZNBC, 0427-0448 Feb 15, after Radio Netherlands closedown in the clear with tribal vocals hosted by a man announcer. No sign of Chad. Poor to fair.
- 6165 CHAD. Radio Chad, *0427-0512 Mar 8, after Radio Netherlands left air, I could hear IS followed by orchestra National Anthem at 0431. A man announcer with ID and sign on announcements in French followed by another man hosting lively program of highlife music with French talks. Poor to fair.
- 6250 EQUATORIAL GUINEA. Radio Nacional – Malabo, 0605-0633 Feb 14, man announcer with news in Spanish language with short music segment at 06-7 before talk by another man. ID by a woman announcer at 0622 followed by a man and woman alternating. Poor to fair signal but UTE QRM marred reception.
- 6297.2 CLANDESTINE (Western Sahara). Radio Nacional de la R.A.S.D. via Rabouni, 0834-0918 Feb 17, non-stop Arabic vocals. Man announcer with Arabic talk at 082 followed by more dinging. Instrumental music at 0900 with Morse Code noted. Woman announcer with ID followed by a man and woman with news. Fair to good signal but began to fade around 0916.
- 9435 SLOVAKIA. IRRS - Rimavska Sobota, 1948-2000* Feb 27, test transmission with Dr. Earl and Word for the World program. Off suddenly without ID. Fair.
- 9655 TURKEY. Voice of Turkey – Cakirlar, 0403-0444 Feb 27, woman announcer with news in English, ID at 0401 followed by commentary and DX Corner featuring news about BBC cutbacks. Fair to good.
- 11780 BRAZIL. Radio Nacional da Amazonia, 0304-0327 Feb 22, series of IDs followed by a man announcer with talk in Portuguese. Into very enjoyable Brazilian pop vocals at 0307. Fair.
- 15250 CUBA. Radio Nacional de Venezuela, 2303-2316 Feb 26, woman announcer with news in English, ID followed by a speech by a government official about the evils of capitalism in Spanish which was translated by the woman announcer into English. Fair.

Adventist World Radio Annual DX Contest “Choose a Channel” AWR 40th Anniversary DX Contest

To commemorate the 40th anniversary of Adventist World Radio, our DX program “Wavescan” is conducting a big worldwide DX contest, “Choose a Channel”. It was back on October 1, 1971, that AWR made its first broadcast on shortwave in a service originating out of Portugal and beamed towards various countries in Europe.

Here are the details of our 2011 “Choose a Channel” DX Contest:

A. Choose a Channel

We invite you to choose any shortwave channel, just one channel, anywhere in the world upon which Adventist World Radio is broadcasting, during the month of June 2011.

B. Prepare Reception Reports

You are invited to listen to the shortwave channel that you have chosen at any time, day and/or night, during the month of June 2011, and see how many different stations, including Adventist World Radio, that you can hear on that one specific channel. You are invited to prepare a standard reception report for each station, one sheet of paper for each station.

C. Photocopies

You are invited to search your QSL collection, and where possible, provide a photocopy of a QSL that you already hold in your collection from each of the shortwave stations that you hear on that one channel. These photocopies should be in color if possible, but black & white is also acceptable. If you do not already have a QSL from any of the stations you select, then you should state so in your contest entry.

D. Three Radio Cards

Where possible, you are invited to include three radio cards for the Indianapolis Heritage Collection with your contest entry. These cards may be old or new, and they may be QSL cards, reception report cards, or picture cards of radio stations, etc. (Not valid for this contest are amateur cards nor CB cards.)

E. Assemble Your Contest Entry

Post your entry with all items to Adventist World Radio in Indianapolis, remembering that the total number of stations you hear on the channel, and neatness and preparation, will all feature in the judging procedure. Remember also, that we will then post your reception reports to the other shortwave stations involved, requesting them to issue QSL cards to you in response.

Other Contest Details

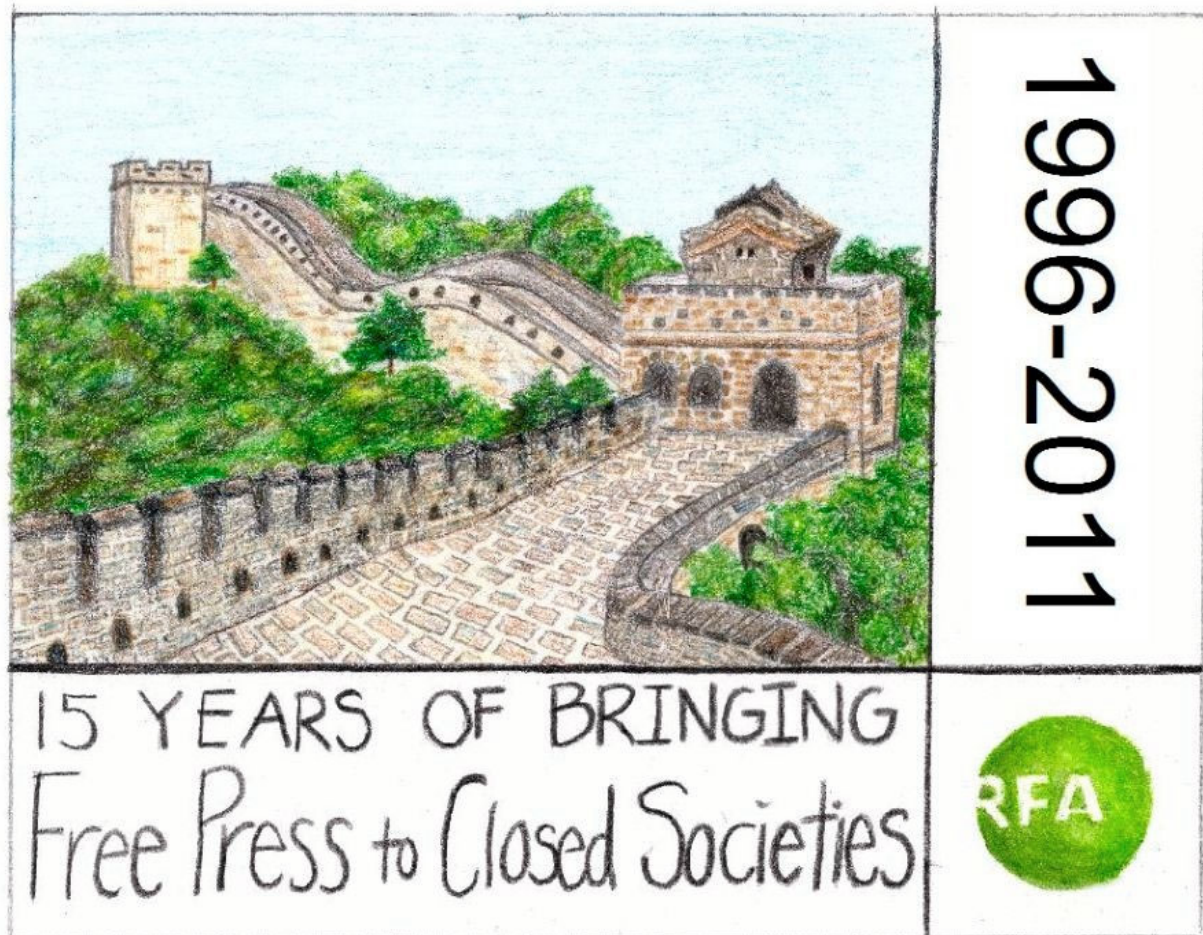
Well, there you have it, the details for our Wavescan 2011 “Choose a Channel DX Contest”. This contest will run through the month of June 2011, and all contest entries should be postmarked at your local post office anywhere in the world on any date up to the end of the month of June, and they should be received at the AWR post office address in Indianapolis no later than the end of the month of July 2011. Return postage in the form of currency notes in an international currency, or mint postage stamps, or IRC coupons would be welcome. Where possible, a self addressed return envelope, business size or half quarto size, would also be welcome. The awards for this year’s contest will be similar to all previous contests. There will be a special award for the world winner, one of the Jerry Berg radio history books; and World Radio TV Handbook 2012 for each continental winner. In addition, there will be other special awards as well as AWR souvenirs and radio curios for many participants. You can remember that all AWR reception reports will be verified with a specially endorsed AWR QSL card. Please remember that it will take a period of many months, well into the new year 2112, to process all of the contest entries and reception reports, but each will in due course be processed.

Radio Free Asia (RFA) announces the release of the 36th QSL card. This is the first to commemorate 2011 as RFA's 15th anniversary with more cards expected throughout the year. RFA's first broadcast was in Mandarin Chinese on September 29, 1996 at 2100 UTC. Acting as a substitute for indigenous free media, RFA concentrates its coverage on events occurring in and/or affecting the countries to which it broadcast. Those countries are: Burma, Cambodia, Laos, North Korea, Peoples Republic of China and Vietnam. This QSL card will be used to confirm all valid reception reports from April 1 – June 30, 2011. The artwork depicts the Great Wall of China and is used by permission of the artist Sarah L. Handler.



Radio Free Asia (RFA) is a private, nonprofit corporation that broadcasts news and information to listeners in Asian countries where full, accurate, and timely news reports are unavailable. Created by US-Congress in 1994 and incorporated in 1996, RFA currently broadcasts in Burmese, Cantonese, Khmer, Korean to North Korea, Lao, Mandarin, the Wu dialect, Vietnamese, Tibetan (Uke, Amdo, and Kham), and Uyghur.
