From 28 May onwards for a period of a couple of months, there's a chance you'll hear VL8A running a single-frequency test on 4835 kHz. This is a high-angle skywave, night service intended primarily for a domestic audience within 400 km of the transmitter. The reason for the trial is because the transmitter contractors are unable to maintain the automation system that controls the day-night change-over between 4835 & 2310.

Conversely, if people want to report on 2310 kHz then it might be an idea to do so now in case the test becomes permanent.

Hi Everyone, 1845 UT (now) R. Bahrain coming in at fair levels, best I heard them. 6010, better in USB, may change which sideband depending on splash. Mainly music (western pop) but English over TOH. (Mark Davies, Anglesey, Wales, June 1, dxldy via WOR 1620, DXLD)

BANGLADESH - 4750 Bangladesh Betar, has revised its schedule. Now broadcasting from 0500-1710 UT. Earlier used to switch off at 1500 UT. (Swopan Chakroborty-IND, dxld 20 Apr)
 Nx in En at 1530-1545 UT. (Dave Kenny-UK, via BrDXC-UK 'Communication' Magazine June 5)

BIAFRA [non] - 11870, R. Biafra London (via Wertachtal). Signal on at 1959:30, and into Afro Hi-life music, M announcer in Hausa with opening mentioning "...11.87 megahertz shortwave 25 meterband...", "Radio Biafra London", and phone 044-7831308376 (although some of the numbers were hard to copy due to the rapid pace). Couldn't listen further as thunderstorms were on the doorstep. Weak signal and noisy of course. (7 June) Thanks to Steven Handler's fine website <www.shortwavereport.com>.

BOLIVIA - 4451.2, Radio Santa Ana, Santa Ana de Yacuma 0000 to 0025 on 8 June (Wilkner)

4716.57, Radio Yura, Yura, fading in at 2320 on 2 June; 1020 sign on 9 June (Wilkner)

5580.2, Radio San José, San José de Chiquitos 2340 to 2350 on 5 June

6134.77, Radio Santa Cruz 1000 to 1010 very strong signal 9 June (Robert Wilkner, Pompano Beach, South Florida, NRD 535D -746Pro - R8 - Sony 2010XA, Cumbre DX via WOR 1621, DXLD)

6134.8, June 8 at 0148 weak music audible here with heavy QRM from the TADIL-A bonker on the lo side, constant intruder into the exclusive 49m SWBC band, and lots of storm noise on the band. Is well-known off-frequency of R. Santa Cruz, and I have no doubt this is it. BFO did not help much; music ran past 0201. At 0207 when I had switched to AM, could then barely copy ID, "Transmite Radio Santa Cruz, Bolivia", and more music. 0208 said "Emisora del Instituto ---" algo, some Andean music and off at 0211*. Others report some nights it closes an hour earlier (gh, DXLD)

6134.83, Radio Santa Cruz, 0107-0109*, June 10, just caught the end of their transmission, signing off with their "Santa Cruz" song. Fair. Sign off time seems to vary quite a bit (Brian Alexander, PA, DX Listening Digest)

There are two new license applications for shortwave operations in the USA. One in Nevada for 1 50 KW and 1 x 100 KW transmitters and 4 Rhombic antennas and the other in Alaska with 1 x 250 KW transmitter and a curtain antenna. The Nevada applicant once had the license application for KIMF. Despite European stations leaving the

air, it is not any easier to coordinate frequencies into Europe and North Africa (FCC's Tom Lucey at 2012 NASB Meeting, June NASWA Listeners Notebook via DXLD)

As first reported in DXLD 12-16 of April 18. Bit of new info here is the KIMF connexion, which we suspected: that station had a CP but was never built, in Oregon (gh, DXLD)

A Voice of America site once scheduled for closure was rededicated May 2 in a ceremony featuring the son of broadcasting pioneer Edward R. Murrow. Voice of America Site B, located 15 miles east of Greenville was named for the legendary broadcaster when it opened in 1963. Murrow's name was removed from the building as part of security measures taken after the September 11 terrorist attacks. Murrow's name was returned during a 10 a.m. ceremony held at the site, 3919 VOA Site B Road. The event was open to the public, and tours of the facility were available after the ceremony. The event featured Murrow's son, Casey; Richard M. Lobo, director of the International Broadcasting Bureau; Victor Ashe, member of the Broadcasting Board of Governors; and Congressman Walter B. Jones Jr. It was held in advance of World Press Freedom Day on May 4.

The Broadcasting Board of Governors announced in February 2010 it wanted to close VOA Site B so it could save about \$3.1 million annually and focus on other broadcasting technologies. Jones, together with two other North Carolina Congressmen worked to stop the closure. The closure never came because Congress had difficulties finalizing its 2010-11 budget and funding was included in continuation budgets. The broadcasting board notified Jones in January 2011 that the administration wouldn't pursue the site's closure.

By that time Victor Ashe, former mayor of Knoxville, Tennessee., and former ambassador to Poland, joined the board and toured the VOA Site B facility. Ashe said he was impressed by the facility's staff members and their dedication to the organization's mission. "We believe free and honest information is a prelude and a foundation of a democratic society," he said. Like other proponents of the site Ashe said it's important to keep VOA Site B operating as it's the only short-wave VOA facility operating under U.S. jurisdiction. Other short-wave locations can be shut down at the insistence of its host nation. Other methods of broadcasting, FM/MW relays, television, the Internet and social media, can be cut off or blocked.

- 5952.4 BOLIVIA. Radio Pio Doce, 2346-0045 Apr 23, long talk in Spanish by a man announcer. Several announcements at 2352 followed by ID at 2358 and brief song. Talk by a man and woman alternating with lively music features. Fair.
- 5925.0 CYPRUS. Cyprus Broadcasting Corporation, 2223-2237 May 20, woman announcer with talk in Greek language. Seemed to commence a radio play around 2226. Poor reception on this channel but //7220 was almost fair and 9760 was good. Next week on Sunday strong carrier on 9760 but no audio.
- 5954.2 COSTA RICA. Radio Republica (presumed), 0156-0159* Apr 20, male vocal selection until carrier terminated without announcements. Poor.
- 5995.0 MALI. Radiodiffusion-Télévision Malienne, 2349-0001* Apr 24, man announcer with French talk, brief instrumental music at 2357 followed by another man with closedown. Off after vocal national anthem. Fair to good signal but weak modulation.
- 6134.8 BOLIVIA. Radio Santa Cruz, 0016-0205* Apr 19 & 20, program of Latin vocals with a male announcer with Spanish talk, ID and announcements. First night gave up around 0130 but second night stayed to closedown with formal ID but no Santa Cruz song this night. Fair.
- 6165.0 CHAD. Radio Chad (presumed), 2247-2254* Apr 21, non-stop highlife vocals until carrier suddenly terminated. Fair.
- 6160.0 CANADA (Newfoundland). CKZN – St. John's, 2334-0005 Apr 25, man announcer in English hosting feature on environmental matters followed by another about a lawyer spending a year in Afghanistan doing legal work. Local weather at 2358 followed by "This is CBC Radio 1" ID, program promos and CBC News at top of the hour. Poor to fair.
- 7255.0 NIGERIA. Voice of Nigeria, 2251-2300* Apr 24, man announcer in studio talking to another man from remote location in local language. Mention Voice of Nigeria followed by orchestra national anthem. Fair.
- 9265.0 USA. WINB – Red Lion, 2339-0003 May 28, man and woman in English with religious talk until program followed by Bible Commentary program by Church of God in Cleveland, OH. Nice formal ID at 0000 and postal address for reports. Fair to good.
- 9445.0 INDIA. All India Radio – Bangaluru, 2122-2147 Apr 18, woman announcer in English hosting feature program. Nice ID at 2140 ("You are listening to the General Overseas Service of All India Radio.") followed by a music program. Fair to good signal. //11670 was good.
- 9655.0 ALASKA. KNLS – Anchor Point, 0920-1025 May 5, Chinese language program. IS at 1000 followed by opening of English language program. Opening ID: "this is Alaska Calling. You are listening to KNLS Anchor Point, Alaska, United States of America." Series of short features such as Postcards from Alaska and Letters to my Children. Fair signal.
- 9680.0 TAIWAN. Radio Taiwan International, 1055-1112 May 9, vocals at tune in possibly RRI Jakarta with poor signal. At 1100 5+1 time pips and opening of the Mandarin language program from RTI with a woman announcer. After opening announcements, the news followed. Fair signal.
- 9685.0 BOSNIA. International Radio of Serbia – Bijeljina, 0040-0053 May 16, English service with discussion about theater in Serbia followed by popular music segment. Excellent signal.
- 9750.0 GERMANY. Radio Free Europe / Radio Liberty – Lamperttheim, 0146-0157* May 6, talks by a man and woman in listed Kazakh language. Off suddenly with carrier terminated. Fair.
- 9750.0 UNITED ARAB EMIRATES. FEBA Radio – Dhabbaya, *0200-0211 May 6, noted familiar IS alternating with ID prior to opening ID and announcements by a woman announcer in listed Urdu language. Man commenced religious talks. Fair.
- 9835.0 MALAYSIA. Radio Television Malaysia Sarawak FM, 1017-1112 May 7, program of pop music vocals hosted by a woman announcer with Malay talks. Man with canned ID at 1032 followed by music. Woman announcer gave ID again at 1042. Time pips at top of the hour followed by news. Fair signal.

- 9955.0 USA. WRMI – Miami, 0350-0403 May 28, man with preaching in English from a Ministry in Tampa, FL followed by program close at 0358 with jamming returning at 0359 presumably timed with anti-Castro programming commencing. Fair until channel became useless after jamming started.
- 11560.0 CLANDESTINE (Sudan). Radio Miraya, 0348-0405 May 5, English lyric pop vocals; mix of English and Arabic talks with jingle ID and jingle program ID for Breakfast Show. News at 0400. Poor to fair.
- 11595.0 CLANDESTINE (Burma). Democratic Voice of Burma – Gavar, 2327-0030* Apr 30, open carrier followed by tones at 2329 before instrumental music opening, ID, opening announcements and news in Burmese. Many speeches in English noted with Burmese translations. Fair.
- 11620.0 INDIA. All India Radio – Khmpur, 0032-0050 Apr 30, program of non-stop Hindi vocals until 0045 ID followed by a woman announcer introducing a man who spoke in Urdu language. Good signal.
- 11670.0 INDIA. All India Radio – Bengaluru, 2210-2227 May 27, English program with woman announcer talking about cricket. At 2215 ID followed by program entitled "Woman in the Performing Arts." Fair to good.
- 11730.0 BELARUS. Radio Belarus, 2210-2300* May 28, program with pop music, vocals hosted by a woman announcer with talk in French language. Isn't this supposed to be an English segment? Poor to fair.
- 11735.0 ZANZIBAR. Zanzibar Broadcasting Corporation, 2034-2058* May 28, finally got a chance to tune them in since return to shortwave with program of lively vocals hosted by a man announcer with brief Swahili talks. Brief talk by man and woman at 2056 followed by flute music and a woman announcer with closedown. Carrier cut at 2058. Good signal.)
- 11870.0 CLANDESTINE (Nigeria). Radio Biafra London, 2031-2059* Apr 21, man with heavily accented English with talks about Nigeria. Nice ID and frequency announcement at 2045 followed by talks in presumed Igbo language. Seemed to mix two languages during broadcast. Fair.
- 11905.0 SRI LANKA. Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation, 153-1210* May 17, nice program of regional music hosted by a woman announcer with talks in listed Tamil language. Man announcer with closedown at 1206. Poor to fair.
- 12080.0 AUSTRALIA. Radio Australia – Brandon, 0853-0915 May 22, magazine style program with features about a new online music streaming service, Facebook's stock dropping after initial offering and big Rugby match for the next evening. Fair to good.
- 12085.0 MONGOLIA. Voice of Mongolia, 1025-1037 May 7, brief talk in listed Mandarin language noted prior to some instrumental music until carrier terminated at 1028. Returned at 1030 with English program with a woman announcer giving opening ID and announcements followed by the news. Poor signal.
- 12085.0 MONGOLIA. Voice of Mongolia, 0906-0933 May 28, woman announcer with news in Japanese language. After news mainly talks with brief music segments until closing vocal selection prior to IS at 0929 and opening of Mongolian program by a man and woman announcing team. Poor to fair.
- 15190.0 EQUATORIAL GUINEA. Radio Africa, 1854-1916 May 19, man preaching in English Language followed by choir singing and then alternating between talk and singing. Not station break at top of the hour just continued program. Poor signal with deep fades.
- 15191.4 BRAZIL. Radio Inconfidência, 0232-0326 May 16, Brazilian pop music and romantic songs hosted by a man announcer with Portuguese language talk, ID, several ads. Nice formal canned ID and frequency announcement at 0300. Poor to fair.
- 15275.0 THAILAND. Radio Thailand, 0002-0030* May 16, man and woman announcer team with news in English. Several ID and usual array of promotional announcements. Fading down by closedown. Poor.
- 15470.0 BONAIRE. Radio Vaticana, 0207-0227* May 16, Spanish language program consisting mainly of talks with some music segments. Several nice IDs. Man announcer with ID and sign off announcements at 0226 with carrier terminated shortly thereafter. Fair.
- 15850.0 ISRAEL. Galei Zahal, 2347-0041 May 15, pop and rock music selection some with English lyrics hosted by a woman announcer with talk in Hebrew language. ID by woman at 0300 prior to news. Back to pop music program from 0003. Fair with //6973 barely audible but essentially buried in the noise.
